Consideration of Replies to Notice and Show Cause Notice: (Volume- 02)

AP</p>	<p>Ushodaya D.Ed College, Plot No.452/C, 450/ABC, 450/ABC, 453/C, Kalugotla Village, Yemmiganur Post and Taluk, Yemmiganur City, Kurnool District-518360, Andhra Pradesh</p> <p>Rayalaseema Minority Health and Educational Development Plot No.450/A/B/C, Kalugotla Road, Yemmiganur Village and Post, Yemmiganur City and Taluk, Kurnool District-518360, Andhra Pradesh had applied for grant of recognition to Ushodaya D.Ed College, Plot No.452/C, 450/ABC, 450/ABC, 453/C, Kalugotla Village, Yemmiganur Post and Taluk, Yemmiganur City, Kurnool District-518360, Andhra Pradesh for D.E.C.Ed Course of two year duration under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE online on 29.09.2011 and physical application has been received in the office of SRC on 30.09.2011.</p> <p>The application was scrutinized and a copy of application was sent to State Government for recommendation on 08.12.2011(Reminder).A deficiency letter was issued to the institution on SRC 28.12.2011.</p> <p>The institution has not submitted reply to the deficiency letter even after stipulated period of 60 days.</p> <p>As per sub-clause (1) of Clause 7 of NCTE Regulation 2009, the applicant institutions is required to submit deficiencies to the Southern Regional Committee Office Within 60 days from the date of receipt of communication of deficiencies, failing which the application will be treated as rejected and closed, no extension to time will be granted and any submission received after 60 days will be treated as invalid and not entertained.</p> <p>The SRC in its 221st Meeting held on 19th-20th April, 2012 considered the matter, as the institution has not submitted reply for deficiency letter even after stipulated period of 60 days from the date of issue of deficiency letter and with reference to the totality of information collected & based on a collective application of mind, the committee decided as per clause 7(1) of NCTE Regulations 2009, to refuse and reject the application of the institution for recognition of D.El.Ed course.</p> <p>Accordingly, a rejection order was issued to the institution vide no. F.No.SRCAPP1197/D.E.C.Ed/Andhra Pradesh/2012-13/41825 dated 30/05/2012. Aggrieved by the rejection order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to</p>
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NCTE-Hqrs vide no. F.No.89-230/2013 Appeal/12th Meeting-2013 dated 26/08/2013 stating that "...the council concluded that the appeal deserved to be remanded to SRC with a direction to consider the reply of the appellant dated 23.02.2012 to be resubmitted by the appellant and take further action as per the regulations. The appellant is also directed to send a copy of his reply with all its enclosures to the SRC immediately.

NOW THEREFORE, the council hereby remands back the case of Ushodaya D.Ed College, Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above."

The SRC in its 254th meeting held on 25th-27th October 2013, considered the Appellate Authority order dated 26/08/2013 directing Southern Regional Committee to consider the reply of the appellant dated 23.02.2012 to be resubmitted by the appellant and take further action as per the regulations and to process further after the appellant as per the direction of the appellate authority to submit a copy of his reply with its enclosures to SRC immediately.

As per the direction of appellate order and as per the decision of SRC, a letter was sent to the institution on 23.10.2013 regarding resubmission of Deficiency letter reply.

The institution has submitted its written representation 06.11.2013.(D.L.Reply)

The Committee in its 255th meeting held on 13-15th November, 2013 considered the matter, written reply of the institution vide letter dated 06-11-2013 to the deficiency letter and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under section 14(1) of NCTE Act, for the following:

- Bye-law of the Society (Certificate of Registration of Society) are not submitted by the institution.
- Land document submitted in Telugu version is not certified by the Sub-registrar. Notarised English version of the certified land documents are not submitted by the institution.
- The institution has submitted photocopy of the building completion certificate in individual name (in the name of Sri M.Md. Pasha) which is not permissible as per NCTE regulations 2009. The Survey number is also not mentioned. At column No. 2 of the building plan, it is mentioned the owner of the land and building as individual.
- Notarised land usage certificate from the Revenue divisional office stating that the agriculture land converted to non-agriculture for the educational purpose is not submitted. Proceedings of Revenue Divisional Officer not submitted for conversion of land from agricultural to educational purposes.
- Up-to-date encumbrance certificate issued by sub-registrar is not submitted.
- FDR for Rs. 5 lacs expired on 20.10.2013, which is not being renewed.
- Proof of completion of 3 academic sessions towards existing courses which are already run by the institution from the affiliating body/State Govt/examining body is not submitted.

		<p>Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 02/01/2014. The Institution has submitted its written reply on 16/01/2014.</p> <p>The Committee considered the reply to the show cause notice from the Institution vide letter dated 16/01/2014 and all other relevant documents and decided to <u>cause inspection</u> under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act, to examine whether the Institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the Institution, as per the norms.</p>

Teacher Training Institute, Pattukonampatti Post, Dharmapuri District, Pin-636905 Tamilnadu.</p> <p>P.D. Rajan College of Education and P.D.R. Teacher Training Institute, Pattukonampatti Post, Dharmapuri District, Pin-636905 Tamilnadu had submitted an application for B.Ed Course on 20.12.2004. The institution has granted recognition on 17.11.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students. Further, the institution has submitted the applications for D.T.Ed (APS04872) course on 02.01.2006 and D.T.Ed-AI (APS08152) course on 02.01.2007. The institution has granted recognition for D.T.Ed (APS04872) course on 11.10.2006 with an annual intake of 50 students and D.T.Ed-AI (APS08152) course on 11.01.2008, thus making an annual intake of 100 students, which includes the existing intake of 50 and additional intake of 50 students, with the condition to shift to own premises within 3 years.</p> <p>The institution vide its letter dtd. 20.01.2012 and 19.03.2012 has requested for change of management from MERIT Trust to P.D.Rajan Memorial Educational Society.</p> <p>Now, the institution vide its letter dtd. 04.07.2012 has stated that “ our application for permission for the change of Management of P.D.Rajan College of Education and P.D.Rajan Teacher Training Institute from Madras and Research Integrated Trust (MERIT) to P.D. Rajan Memorial Educational Society. As the academic year 2012-2013 has commenced and the Management of MERIT Trust has decided not to allow any confusion in the minds of the General Public and the students as to which Management is going to have control over P.D.R. College of Education and P.D.R Teacher Training Institute. MERIT Trust has decided to withdraw the Application submitted to NCTE (SRC), Bangalore letter dtd. 30.01.2012. Our Request for the Change of Management from <u>MERIT Trust</u> to <u>P.D.Rajan Memorial Educational Society</u> may be withdrawn.</p> <p>We request that this withdrawal may be recorded and necessary orders may be issued regarding the withdrawal of our application for change of Management”.</p> <p>The SRC may take a note regarding withdrawal of request of change of management.</p> <p>The SRC in its 230th meeting held on 16th-17th August, 2012 considered the request of the management vide their letter dt.30.01.2012 for <u>withdrawal</u> of application for change of management from <u>MERIT Trust</u> to “<u>P.D. Rajan Memorial Education Society</u>”</p> <p>The institution vide its letter dtd. 13.08.2012 has submitted DD bearing no. 882651 dtd. 10.08.2012 for Rs. 50,000/- towards change of place from Pattukonampatti to Pappireddipatti, Dharmapuri District for B.Ed course and had stated the following:- “National Council for Teacher Education(SRC) Bangalore was pleased to accord</p>

	<p>Recognition to start B.Ed course by P.D.R. College of Education at Pattukonampatti, Pappireddipatti (Po) & (Tk), Dharmapuri District with an intake of 100 students from 2005-2006. Based on the Recognition order of NCTE (SRC), Bangalore, Periyar University granted affiliation to P.D.R. College of Education from 2005-2006.</p> <p>Consequent on the formation of Tamilnadu Teacher Education University, all the colleges of Education that were earlier affiliation to different Universities within their jurisdictions in Tamilnadu, came under the unitary control of Tamilnadu Teacher Education University w.e.f. 1.7.2007.</p> <p>Madras Education and Research Integrated Trust (MERIT) proposes to shift P.D.R. College of Education functioning at Pappireddipatti (Po) & (Tk), Dharmapuri District to Sekkampatti, Mobripatti Panchayat, Dharmapuri District to a permanent building. The proposed change of location of P.D.R. College of Education has a permanent Building and other infrastructure facilities as per the norms prescribed by the National Council of Education. The library and faculty members will move over to the new place.</p> <p>Under Regulation 8(11) of NCTE Act, a demand draft for Rs. 50,000/- from State Bank of India, Harur, Dharmapuri District is enclosed for necessary approval after due inspection of the institution at the new site viz Sekkampatti, Mobripatti Panchayat, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District. We are willing to submit any other particulars required by NCTE(SRC).</p> <p>We pray that NCTE(SRC) may be pleased to make arrangements for earlier inspection and approval for change of place of P.D.R. College of Education”.</p> <p>The SRC in its 233rd meeting held on 26th -28th September 2012, considered the written reply and other relevant documents submitted by the institution and decided to <u>cause composite inspection</u> for shifting at the new premises and to ascertain infrastructural and instructional facilities Under NCTE Act. Accordingly, inspection was carried out on 27.11.2012.</p> <p>The SRC in its 237th meeting held on 05th -06th January, 2013 considered the Institutions request for closure of D.T.Ed, D.T.Ed – AI courses vide letter dt. 30.10.2012 and decided to permit the closure by withdrawing the recognition for (APS04872) D.T.Ed, (APS08152) D.T.Ed – AI courses with effect from 2012-2013, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in D.T.Ed, D.T.Ed-AI courses, if any, to complete their final year course. Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 15.03.2013 for D.T.Ed and D.T.Ed-AI courses.</p> <p>Further, the SRC in its 237th meeting held on 05th -06th January, 2013 considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences of B.Ed course and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.03.2013. The institution had submitted its written representation on 05.04.2013.</p> <p>The SRC duly considered the written reply of the institution and noted that many deficiencies are still there even after grant of many opportunities for their removal, decided to reject the application for shifting. Further, the SRC in its 246th meeting held on 02nd -06th January 2013 considered the written reply of the institution vide letter dt.05.04.2013 on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution, the deficiencies still persists</p>
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- and decided to withdraw recognition for both B.Ed for the following reasons:-
1. Original approved building plan issued by competent civil authority is not submitted. In the approved building plan copy submitted, total land area is not mentioned, moreover, all the rooms shown as class rooms in the building plan, instead of specifying the rooms for Laboratory, library, Principal room, office, multipurpose hall etc., multipurpose hall size is also not mentioned.
 2. Original FDRs of Rs. 5 & 3 lacs towards endowment and reserve fund from a Nationalized Bank in joint name is not submitted.
 3. Notarised land usage certificate from the Revenue divisional office stating that the agriculture land converted to non-agriculture for the educational purpose is not submitted. Proceedings of Revenue Divisional Officer not submitted for conversion of land from agricultural to educational purposes.
 4. For the deficiency point (14) of the show cause notice, the institution has replied that the Associate professor S. Manimizhi qualified with M.Sc & M.Ed joined on 01.06.2012 in handling foundation courses. But the name of the same lecturer is not found in the approved staff list. Qualification certificate, marks cards etc., as per Annexure I, II, & II not submitted for Lecturer in Physical Education.
 5. Lecturer in Fine Arts is not qualified for the post as per NCTE norms.

The reply of the institution is not convincing and not satisfactory. Based on the above grounds. The committee decides to withdraw the recognition of the B.Ed (APS03809) course run by P.D. Rajan College of Education and P.D.R Teacher Training Institute, Pattukonampatti Post, Dharmapuri District-636905, Tamilnadu from the academic year 2013-14, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in B.Ed course, if any, to complete their course.

But it is made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order for both B.Ed course.

The Affiliating body / Examining board / body be informed accordingly.

Further decided to return Endowment funds and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore if any, when all the admitted students complete their course & settlement of all faculty/staff claims.

Accordingly, withdrawn order was issued to the institution on 11.07.2013.

The institution, preferred appeal to NCTE, Hqrs and the Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No. 89-495/2013 Appeal/15th meeting-2013/A77964/ dated 12.11.2013 has stated as follows:-

“after perusal of the documents, Memorandum of appeal, affidavit, the documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council concluded that the appeal deserves to be remanded to SRC with a direction to re-consider the explanations given by the appellant institution and till then the withdrawal order dated 11.07.2013 may be kept in abeyance. The case may be decided within two months of the receipt of the order of the Appellate Authority.

NOWHEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of P.D. Rajan College of Education, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above.”

The same was considered by the committee in its 246th meeting held on 02nd - 04th June, 2013 and rejected on the ground that the institution is already running with an intake of B.Ed (100), B.Ed-AI (100), and M.Ed (25+10=35). Total enrolment will exceed more than 300 if the present application for B.Ed (SRCAPP1862) is allowed.

As per 8(3) of regulations 2009:

An institution can apply for one basic unit only of an additional course or for an additional unit of the existing recognised course after completion of three academic sessions of the respective course, for which the institution shall submit application before the cut off date prescribed for submission of applications in the year succeeding the completion of three academic sessions. The Committee considered the matter, reply of the institution to the show cause notice issued, examined all the 3 courses run by the institution, and

The SRC in its 235th Meeting held on 21st-22nd November, 2012 considered the Appellate authority order dt. 10/10/2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act.

Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 19/12/2012. The institution has submitted written representation on. 03/01/2013.

The SRC in its 240th meeting held on 9th-11th March 2013, considered the reply of the institution dt.03-01-2013 and all other relevant documents and decided to **cause inspection** under section 14 of NCTE Act, to examine whether the institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the institution, as per the norms.

Accordingly, inspection of the institution was fixed between 3rd to 6th July 2013, the same was intimated to the institution on 20.06.2013.

As per the direction of SRC, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 04.07.2013 and the VT Report received in the office of SRC on 08.07.2013

On careful perusal of the original file of the institution, reply of the institution, all relevant documents and other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE published from time to time laid on the table, the Regional Committee in its 249th meeting held on 24-26th July, 2013 decided to issue Letter of Intent for grant of recognition to D.Ed course of two year duration with an annual intake of 50(Fifty only)(one unit), subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

LOI issued to the institution vide letter dated 27/08/2013

The institution has replied to LOI on 24/09/2013.

The Committee in 254th meeting held on 25-27th Oct, 2013 considered the matter and noted that the institution is already running 5 courses other than the new application SRCAPP841-D.Ed course applied for the session 2012-13. Committee has decided and advised Southern Regional Office to examine details carefully and put up again in the 255th meeting with a comparative statement covering all the 5 courses.

As per the direction of SRC, the details of other 5 courses run by the said institution are given.

The Committee considered and examined all the 5 course run by the

Hence, certified copy of the registered land documents in the name of the institution is required.
- Approved blue print of building plan is not submitted. Total land area is also not mentioned.
- Original affidavit is not submitted. In affidavit Sy. No. not mentioned.
- Building completion certificate not submitted.
- Notarized copy of Land use certificate is not submitted.
- Non-Encumbrance certificate is not submitted.
- Photocopy of FDRs for 5.00 lakhs & 3.00 lakhs submitted. Required to submit original FDRs. Original FDRs were not shown to VT members for verification.
- The total land area is only 16053 sq.ft which is grossly inadequate against the requirement of 2500 aq.mts as per NCTE norms & standards, 2009 for one unit of B.Ed.
- The library has 3256 books only. Since it has been running since 2008-09, therefore, the library should have been augmented with addition of 200 books annually and it has now at least 3800 books.
- As per VT report, language learning lab needs to be strengthened.
- 1+6 faculty is inadequate for one unit of B.Ed against the requirement of 1+7+2 as per NCTE norms & standards, 2009.
- Lecture(s) in fine Arts/Physical Education are not available.
- As per staff profiles and VTR, consolidated salary is being paid in cash which is not allowed as per NCTE norms & standards, 2009.
- Fresh VCD to be submitted.

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 04.07.2012. The institution submitted its reply on 23.07.2012.

The SRC in its 229th meeting held on 30th-31st July,2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 23.07.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show Cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following:

- Approved blue print of the building plan issued by competent civil authority is not submitted. The copy of the building plan submitted is not clear and readable. In the building plan all the rooms are given nomenclature as class rooms, it is not being segregated for Principal, multipurpose hall, seminar hall and labs.
- Original Affidavit in the prescribed form on Rs. 100/- stamp paper duly attested by oath Commissioner or notary public, is not submitted.
- Original FDRs of Rs. 5 & 3 lacs towards endowment and reserve fund from a Nationalised Bank in favour of Society/college/institution & in joint name is not given.
- Approved staff list from the concerned affiliating body/University is not submitted with their percentage of marks and grade.
- No documentary proof is made available for payment of salary to the staff by Cheque through Bank.

Accordingly, by seeing the website the institution had submitted its written representation on 27.08.2012.

The SRC in its 233rd meeting held on 26th-28th September, 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 27.08.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show Cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following:

- In the letter submitted to SRC, the institution has stated that 1+10 faculty members are available, whereas in the letter submitted to TTEU, only 1+9 faculty members are mentioned.
- Lecturer in foundation course is not appointed.
- Lecturer in Fine Arts is not eligible.
- Up-to-date encumbrance certificate issued by sub-registrar is not submitted. Notarised English version of encumbrance certificate is also not submitted.

Accordingly, a Final Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 29.10.2012. The institution had submitted its written representation on 05.11.2012.

The SRC in its 235th meeting held on 21st -22nd November, 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 05.11.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following:

The SRC in its 240th meeting held on 09th -11th March, 2013 and decide to withdraw recognition Minutes not yet finalized.

In the meantime, the institution moved to the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras in W.P.no. 5526 of 2013 and interim order dtd.19.03.2013 reads as under:-

“..... this petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/SB.RABU MANOHAR, Advocate for the petitioner the cost made the following order:-

There shall be an order of interim injunction for a period of three weeks.

The above was placed before SRC in its 241st meeting held on 30th-31st March &

1st April, 2013 and SRC decided to process and put up 242nd meeting. A letter was sent to the advocate on 09.04.2013 to vacate the stay.

Further, SRC NCTE has received interim order dt 19.03.2013 on 08.04.2013 which reads as under

“... the petitioner above named has presented the above petition, praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support thereof, a copy of which is annexed hereto, the High Court will be pleased to pass an order of interim injunction, restraining the Respondent from withdrawing the recognition granted to the petitioner institution dt. 20.02.2008, pending disposal of this writ petition and whereas the petition will come up for hearing on 09.04.2013, you are hereby directed to appear, in person or by advocate, to show cause why the petitioner’s prayer should not be granted, in default of which, the matter will be heard and decided in your absence”.

SRC NCTE has received interim injunction dt. 19.03.2013 on 25.03.2013 which reads as under:-

“ There shall be an order of interim injunction for a period of three weeks”.

The SRC in its 242nd meeting held on 14th-16th April, 2013 considered the Hon’ble High Court interim Injunction order dt. 19.03.2013 received on 25.03.2012 and decided as under:

- 1) To move for vocation of ‘interim stay’ if stay continues, if final order is not received within 2 days. Check with lawyer.
- 2) If the final order allows the petition, file an appeal.
- 3) The institution was given/shown extraordinary consideration by giving 4 show cause notices to rectify the deficiencies. But, even then the deficiencies are persisting.

Further, the committee reiterates that the order of withdrawal of recognition of the institution is in order, as It is a case of strict application of norms and standards as directed by S,C, in their order dt. 31-01-2011 in case Civil Appeal No.1125-1128/2011 inSLP, SLP No. 17165-68/2009 filed by NCTE Vs ors, which reads as under:

“An institution is not entitled to recognition unless it fulfills the conditions specified in various clauses of the Regulations. The Council is directed to ensure that in future no institution is granted recognition unless it fulfils the conditions laid down in the Act and the Regulations and the time schedule fixed for processing the application by the Regional Committee and communication of the decision on the issue of recognition it strictly adhered to.”

The Committee considered the matter and advised Southern Regional Office to further process and put up for necessary decision Accordingly, a letter sent to the advocate on 19.04.2013.

The Hon’ble High Court of Judicature at Madras in W.P. No. 6626 of 2013 and MP No. 1 of 2013 and interim order dtd. 25.04.2013 which reads as under:-

The management has admitted in its reply received by SRC on 08.05.2012 that they could not register the land before application submission & registered land on 01.12.2011 and other documents like land usage certificate, building completion certificate, encumbrance certificate etc. also indicate the transaction after the date of Registration 01.12.2011.

Under the above grounds and with reference to the totality of information collected & based on a collective application of mind, the committee has decided as per NCTE Regulations 2009 to refuse and reject the application of the institution for recognition of D.Ed course.

Accordingly, a rejection order was issued to the institution vide no. F.No.SRCAPP1332/D.Ed/AP/2012-13/43287 dated 29.06.2012.

The institution preferred appeal to NCTE, Hqrs and the Appellate Authority vide no. F.No. 89-381/2012 Appeal/8th Meeting –2012 dated 18.09.2012 has stated that “...the application of the institution be processed by the SRC in accordance with the extant Regulations, relaxed by the NCTE Committee with regard to the date of the registration of the land documents. The council concluded that there was adequate ground to remand the case to the SRC with a direction to process the application and to take the further decision thereafter.

The council hereby remands back the case of Sharada D.Ed College, Plot/Khasara No.8, Hanwada Village, Post and Taluk, Mahabubnagar District – 509334, Andhra Pradesh to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above”.

In obedience to the Appellate authority order dated 24.09.2012, the SRC in its 233rd Meeting held on 26th –28th September 2012 decided to process the application.

Accordingly, the application was processed and placed before SRC in its 234th meeting held on 17th –18th October 2012 considered the Appellate authority order dt. 24-09-2012 alongwith relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act, for the following:

- As per notarized English version of the land document submitted, the land is in favour of joint name, i.e, it is in applicant society's name and also with some individual name viz; Shri R.Sanjeeva Reddy, which is not permissible as per NCTE norms.
- In the building plan submitted, proposed institution's name is not mentioned.
- As per affidavit submitted, total built up area mentioned as 1645 sq.mtrs, whereas, in building completion certificate it is given as 23484 sq.ft.

Accordingly show cause notice was issued to the institution on 16.11.2012. The institution has submitted its written representation on 26.11.2012.

The reply of the institution to the show cause notice was duly considered by the SRC in its 236th Meeting held on 16th-18th December, 2012 and the reply is

Since we are not shifting the existing premises to new place. The remittance of Rs. 40,000/- will not arise. As per the VT report , Reserve fund was not deposited in the form of FDR. It is in the S.B A/c of the Society.

From the above explanation and records it is observed that the institution has not submitted the FDRs of Rs. 3 lakhs each(Reserve Fund) maintained in joint account with the Regional Director, SRC.

The SRC in its 246th meeting held on 02nd –0 4th of June, 2013 has considered the written reply of the institution on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition for the following reasons:-

➤ The Institution was granted recognition in temporary premises to run B.Ed course from academic session 2004-2005 with a condition that it should shift to its own permanent premises in 3 years. i.e., on or before 29.11.2007. The Institution is still running in temporary premises and not shifted to new premises even after a lapse of stipulated 3 years and after lapse of time period of more than 8 years.

The management has not shown any seriousness and not cared to reply to this office letter 25/05/2009 regarding shifting and payment of inspection fee.

The institution has not submitted the FDRs of Rs. 3 lac (reserve fund for B.Ed) maintained in joint account with the Regional Director, SRC.

Based on the above points the committee decides to withdraw the recognition of the B.Ed course run by the Bhagwan Buddha College of Education No. 1706, 5th Cross, II Block, Siddharthanagar, Malavalli Town, Mandya District, Karnataka, from the academic year 2013-14, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in B.Ed, course, if any, to complete their course.

But it is made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order. The Affiliating body / Examining board / body be informed accordingly. Further decided to return Endowment funds and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore, if any, after ensuring settlement of all faculty/staff claims.

Accordingly withdrawn order was issued to the institution on 10.07.2013. Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs the appellate authority order no. The Council is directed to ensure that in future no institution is granted recognition unless it fulfils the conditions laid down in the Act and the Regulations and the <u>time schedule fixed for processing the application by the Regional Committee and communication of the decision on the issue of recognition it strictly adhered to</u>”.</p> <p>Based on the above, the institution has not submitted reply for Final Show Cause Notice even after the expiry of stipulated time of 21 days from the date of issue of the notice, the committee decided <u>not to permit/extension of time and to withdraw recognition of the college(APS07263) B.Ed course with effect from 2013-14.</u></p> <p>As per the decision of SRC, recognition of the institution was withdrawn vide this</p>
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office order No. F. No. APSO7263/B.Ed/KL/2013-14/52820 dated 20.07.2013.

It was made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order. The Affiliating Body / Examining Board / Body were informed accordingly. Further decided to return Endowment fund and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore. If any after ensuring settlement of all faculty/ staff claims.

The Institution submitted a written representation on 22.07.2013 explaining the delay in submission of the approved staff list.

A complaint dated 16.07.2013 was received by this office on 22.07.2013 from Mr. Shoukathali. K, Rose Garden, Farook College of Teacher Education for the violation of the NCTE regulations 2009, the matter is as under:-

“This is to inform you that your letter mentioned above is explaining that the Teacher Education has violated the NCTE regulations 2009 as the following aspects:-

1. The land should be in the name of the institution as per NCTE regulations 2009. But their land is in the name of a trust and is not exclusively for the B.Ed course.
2. The college is running in a building which is not approved by the competent authority. So that the approved building plan not submitted at the NCTE.
3. The land is not sufficient as per the NCTE regulations.

In this context. I request you to be necessary action at the earliest, i.e before commencing the next academic year on November 2013 to protect the interest of students.

On 30.08.2013, a letter No. 31523/GA-II-A2/2013/CU from the Deputy Registrar, University of Calicut dated 20.08.2013 is received by this office verification of qualification of teaching staff of KET College of Teacher Education, Kozhikode. The verification report stating that qualification of the staff have been verify with the originals and found correct along with the list of teaching Staff is submitted.

The above matter was placed before has decided as under:-

1. Appeal period is over.
2. Refer the complaint to SCERT(Kerala) and request for information and report.

In the mean while a letter is received on 27.09.2013 from NCTE Hqrs vide letter No. 89-576/2013/Appeal/A74441 dated 17.09.2013. requesting to send original records of the institution.

Aggrieved by the withdrawal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs the appellate authority order no. F.No.89-576/2013 Appeal/17th Meeting 2013 dated 10.01.2014 stating that “...the council concluded that the SRC was justified in refusing recognition and therefore, the appeal deserved to be rejected and the order of the SRC is confirmed.NOW THEREFORE, the Council hereby confirms the Order appealed against.

The Committee has noted the matter.

Certificate of registration/Bye-law of the Society/Trust should be submitted. 8. The Affidavit in Rs. 100/- stamp paper in the prescribed format with notary attestation should be submitted (format enclosed). <p>The Registrar, M.G. University, Kottayam, had forwarded the reply to the notice on 27.07.2009 given to the MGUCTE, of Kudamaloor, Muvattupuzha, Vaikom, Nedumkandam and Erattupetta furnished by the Principals concerned. He had also stated that all the MGUCTE, were directly run by the M.G. University and functioning in Government school buildings and also own buildings constructed by the institution, in government land provided by the Government for running the institutions, A questionnaire duly filled in was also submitted.</p> <p>But, on perusal of the file, it is noted that the reply was not placed before the committee.</p> <p>The SRC in its 221st meeting held on 19th -20th April 2012 considered the reply of the M.G. Based on the above points the committee decided to withdraw the recognition of the B.Ed course (APS03252) run by the M.G. University College of Teacher Education, Nedumkandam, Kerala from the academic year 2013-14, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in B.Ed, course, if any, to complete their course.

But it was made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order. The Affiliating Body / Examining Board / Body were informed accordingly. Further decided to return Endowment funds and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore if any.

As per the decision of SRC, recognition of the institution was withdrawn vide this office order F.SRO.NCTE/APS03252/B.Ed/KL/2013-14/51049 dated 23.04.2013

Further, on 27.09.2013, this office has received an e-mail from Mr. P. Parameswaran Nair, Assistant Solicitor General of India regarding the W.P.(C).No. 23471 of 2013 filed by M.G. University and another before the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala challenging the order of withdrawal of recognition.

In the meanwhile, this office received a letter from NCTE, New Delhi vide NO.91-16th Meeting/2013/Appeal/A74706 dated 27.9.2013 which was received by this office on 30.9.2013 with a request to send original records of the institution along with the comments for taking a decision by the appellate authority.

Accordingly, the original file along with comments of the institution was sent to NCTE, New Delhi on 03.10.2013

On 10.10.2013, this office received a letter from advocate Sri.V.M.Kurian along with a Court Judgement dated 1.10.2013 in W.P.©No.23471/2013 of the Hon'ble Court of Kerala at Ernakulam(copy enclosed). The Judgement of the Hon'ble Court is as under:-

“The only grievance of the petitioner University, when the matter was taken up for hearing was the non-consideration of Ext.P10. Ext.P10 appeal has been filed before the second respondent, and there shall be a direction to the second respondent to expedite the consideration of Ext.P10 appeal, in any event, within a period of one month from today. The writ petition is disposed of as above.”

On 11.10.2013, a Vakalath sent by NCTE, New Delhi regarding the W.P.No.23471/2013 is received by this office along with the letter of Assistant solicitor General of India in the above matter. Accordingly, the matter was communicated to the advocate along with the Vakalath and a brief history of the case and the action taken by this office in this regard on 23.10.2013

Maulana Azad National University is a central University which is dual mode catering to the needs of both the regular and distance mode Urdu medium students across the country.</i></p> <p><i>The B.Ed distance mode programme is being offered by the Directorate of Distance Education, Maulana Azad National Urdu University since 2005 with due recognition from NCTE.</i></p> <p><i>Since Maulana Azad National Urdu University is a central University established by an Act of the Parliament, it does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Andhra Pradesh State Government. It has a national presence with head quarters in Hyderabad, A.P.</i></p> <p><i>The present B.Ed (distance mode) programme as well as the regular mode B.Ed of MANUU is offered in various parts of India since it is a national University. In the past also, no NOC from the State Government was required as a prerequisite to start any course.</i></p> <p><i>Therefore, since the B.Ed. AI (i.e. additional intake of 500 seats) is</i></p>
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*proposed to be started by a national and central university, the clause 7 of the NCTE Regulations 2009 is not applicable in the case the proposals by Directorate of Distance education.
Hence, you are requested to waive the prerequisite of obtaining NOC from the Government of A.P. and grant permission to start B.Ed Additional Unit of 500 from this academic year.”*

The SRC in its 245th meeting held on 19th-21st May 2013, considered the matter and non-reply to the deficiency letter from the ‘Director of Distance Education” (SRCAPP1960) sent on 05.04.2013 and decided to await the reply to the deficiency letter.

Further, the direction of the university to be informed to send the D.L.Reply through Registrar of University, (MANUU).

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the university on 20.06.2013. The university has submitted its written representation on 06.06.2013

The SRC in its 254th meeting held on 25th – 27th October, 2013 considered the reply of the university dt.06-06-2013 to the deficiency letter and all other relevant documents and decided to cause composite inspection to B.Ed (DL) & B.Ed-AI (DL) course after collecting inspection fee under section 14(1) of NCTE Act, to examine whether the university fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the university, as per the norms.

Further, the Committee decided and advised Southern Regional Office to write to the University to pay the Endowment Fund and Reserve Fund of Rs. 5 lacs and 3 lacs respectively, because all Distance Learning courses are self-financing courses.

As per direction of SRC, a letter was sent to university on 13.11.2013.

The university has submitted Endowment fund and Reserve fund on 30.12.2013 but inspection fee not submitted as per decision of SRC.

Accordingly, inspection of the university was fixed between 06th-9th January 2014. The same was intimated to the university on 24.12.2013. The inspection of the university was conducted on 28.12.2013 and the VT Report received in the office of SRC on 01.01.2014

Colleges/ Private Physical Education Colleges/Private Language Pandit Training Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh.</p> <p>Also a letter fr om the NCTE, HQ vide letter No.49-27/NCTE(N&S)/92198 dated 17.3.2009 considered the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh letter dated 7.1.2009 and it has been decided that no further recognition/permission to any institution in the State of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-10 for B.Ed., D.Ed. and Physical Education courses Due to the above policy decisions, the application of Haragopal College of Education for B.Ed. course was kept pending.</p> <p>Meanwhile, the institution has submitted written representation along with a Court order on 15.4.2009 of W.P.No.7462 of 2009. 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order as follows:-

“There shall be an interim direction to the respondents to conduct inspection of the petitioner’s College i.e., Haragopal College of Education at Polaki, Narasannapeta Mandal, Srikakulam Dt., for the purpose of granting recognition to the said College as per law”.

The matter was placed before SRC and SRC decided to conduct inspection as per Court orders the committee decided to cause the inspection of the institution in obedience of the Court order in its W.P.No. 7462 of 2009 dated 15/04/2009. the inspection was conducted on 09/05/2009. the VT report along with documents were placed before 175th Meeting and the SRC refused recognition of the institution.

SRC in its 169th meeting held on 12-13 January 2009 considered the letter dated 07/01/2009 of State Government of Andhra Pradesh wherein Principal Secretary of Education has requested NCTE *“not to accord further recognition/permission to the new colleges/private B.Ed D.Ed Physical Education, language Pandit in the State of Andhra Pradesh as above colleges are exceeding in numbers than required”*.

The SRC decided to give effect to the decision of State Government of Andhra Pradesh as such with immediate effect.

Further, the letter dated 17/03/2009 was received from NCTE-Hqrs informing that the recommendations of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition/permission in respect of other courses like B.Ed & D.Ed and Physical Education courses have further been considered in NCTE and it has been decided that no further recognition / permission to any institution in the State of Andhra Pradesh be considered by SRC for the academic session 2009-10 for B.Ed & D.Ed and Physical Education courses also”.

It was noted that SRC in its 172nd meeting held on 25th-26th March, 2009. and decided to accept the recommendation of the State Government of Andhra Pradesh not to grant recognition to any of the Teacher Training institutions in the state of Andhra Pradesh for the year 2009-10.

Accordingly refusal order was served to the institution on 05/06/2009.

Aggrieved by the refusal order of SRC, the institution preferred an appeal before the Appellate authority. The appellate authority remanded back the case to SRC, NCTE for necessary action. SRC decided to conduct re-inspection on 11/09/2009. the inspection report was placed before SRC in its 183rd meeting of SRC which was held on 22nd September, 2009 wherein the Regional Committee decided to serve notice and notice was served on 29/10/2009 with following reasons:-

1. As per the VT report, the Management is conducting Vishwa Bharathi Public School in the building proposed for B.Ed course. as per para 8 (7) of NCTE regulations no. institution shall be granted recognition under these regulations unless it is in possession of required land on the date of application. “As per records the institution has not submitted the exclusive and land building documents for the proposed course.
2. The built up area is roofed with asbestos sheets which is against para 8 (10) of NCTE regulations, 2007.
3. The furniture is not suitable for the proposed programme and also the furniture belongs to the School children shown to the VT members.

4. Building area available in the building is not suitable (Hall and classrooms) for B.Ed programme.
5. The size of Multipurpose Hall is 851 Sq.ft. as against 1500 Sq.ft. required as per Regulation of NCTE.
6. The equipment for Educational Technology Lab. Is not provided by the Management for proposed course.
7. As per VT report, the land document was registered on 30/08/2008, whereas the Management submitted building completion certificate on 03/10/2008. The Management has to give clarification how the building was constructed within two months.
8. Infrastructural and instructional facilities are inadequate and not as per NCTE norms of B.Ed course.

In reply to show cause notice the institution has submitted written representation dated 18/11/2009.

The reply to the notice was considered by the committee and it has been decided to refuse recognition for B.Ed course.

Accordingly, rejection letter was issued to the institution on 05/01/2010.

The institution has submitted series of letters dt.21/11/2011, 20/12/2011, 16/02/2012 and 26/02/2012 requesting to cause inspection and to issue permission / recognition to start B.Ed course.

Aggrieved by the refusal letter of SRC the institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs and the appellate authority in its order no. F.No.89-239/2012 Appeal/6th Meeting-2012 A55126 dated 17/07/2012 state that *"the Council concluded that the reasons adduced by the appellant for condonation of 2 year, 2 month and 9 days were not acceptable and hence it decided not to condone the delay and admit the appeal"*.

The SRC in its 230th meeting held on 16th to 17th July, 2012 has noted the Appellate authority order dt. 17/07/2012.

The institution moved to court, the Hon'ble High Court order dt. 04/09/2012 in W.P. No. 27491 of 2012 stated that *"...the writ petition is disposed of without adjudicating the same on merits on the short ground that the academic year for which the petitioner has made its No. 2 to entertain a fresh application from the petitioner for the academic year 2012-13 and take a decision there on without reference to and regard for the rejection of the petitioner's earlier application. Subject to the above direction, the disposed of as a sequel to disposal of the writ petition, W.P.M.P. No. 35014 of 2012 shall stand disposed of as infructuous"*.

The SRC in its 239th meeting held on 26th to 27th February, 2013 considered the Hon'ble High Court order dt. 04/09/2012 and decided to close the case. Further, the Committee also decided as per court order to entertain when the second application for the session 2012-13 is received, put up to consider its validity because of the 'On-line' restrictions.

The institution has submitted manual copy of application on 1.8.2013 with all the essential documents for consideration with the request to issue recognition for B.Ed course for the academic year 2013-2014.

NCTE-Hqrs., in its letter dated 4th September, 2013 stating that "the representation received from the petitioner institution along with a copy of manual application for conduct of B.Ed course in context with the Hon'ble High Court amended order dated 25.7.2013. After perusal of the court direction dated

The SRC in its 246th meeting held on 02nd - 04th June, 2013 considered the reply of the institution to the deficiency letter dated 21.05.2013 and all other relevant documents and decided to cause inspection under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act, to examine whether the institution fulfils all the requirements as per the norms, for the proposed programme, subject to the condition that the deficiencies, if any, were duly rectified by the institution, as per the norms.

Accordingly, inspection of the institution was fixed on 16th - 19th July, 2013, The same was intimated to the institution on 10.07.2013.

As per the direction of SRC, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 23.07.2013 and the VT report received in the office of SRC on 26.07.2013.

Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 01.10.2013. The institution has submitted its written representation on 30.09.2013.

On careful perusal of the original file of the institution, VT report, VCD, all relevant documents and other related documents, Act of NCTE, 1993, Regulations and guidelines of NCTE published from time to time laid on the table, the Southern Regional Committee in its 254th Meeting held on 25th - 27th October, 2013 has decided to issue Letter of Intent for grant of recognition to B.P.Ed course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred only) (one unit), subject to the appointment of qualified staff through duly constituted selection committee as per the Norms of NCTE/State Government/Affiliating University and be given effect before the commencement of the academic session.

Accordingly, LOI was issued to the institution on 04.11.2013. The institution has submitted its written representation on 30.12.2013.

As per direction of SRC, a letter has been addressed to the Dean, College Development Council, Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University sent on 29.05.2013.

In the meantime, a private lawyer notice has been received on 30.09.2013 which states as follows:-

"..... it is hereby inform all of you not to prepare any list for admission of B.Ed 2013-14 relating to my client's organization. All of you are held responsible for legal action and all of you made liable for civil and criminal action. All of you are liable to pay a sum of Rs.5,000/- to my client for issue of this notice."

A letter dated 13.10.2013 has been received from Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam, Etcherla on 22.10.2013 stated as under:-

"As per the Hon'ble High Court order cited (1) above and by the direction of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam, temporary and conditional affiliation to St.Mark's College of Education, Mandasa is granted for offering B.Ed programme in the academic year 2013-14, subject to the outcome of the vacate petition of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar University, Srikakulam."

In the meantime, Hon'ble Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P.No.29529 of 2013 dated 10.10.2013 received by SRC on 31.10.2013 and 01.11.2013 court order as stated below:-

"it is brought to my notice that pursuant to the interlocutory order passed by this court on 09.10.2012m Dr.B.R. Ambedkar University, Srikakulam at Etcherla granted conditional affiliation to the 2nd petitioner-St. Mark's College of Education for offering B.Ed programme in the academic year 2012-13, subject to the outcome of the vacate petition to be filed in W.p.No.28523 of 2012. This conditional affiliation was passed by the University on 18.10.2012. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that, so far no vacate stay petition is filed and consequently the affiliation granted on 18.10.2013 is confined only for the year 2012-13 and they are not granting once again for the academic year 2013-14 from this court.

Dr.B.R. Ambedkar, respondent No.2 is directed to immediately grant affiliation for the academic year 2013-14 and in case the W.P.No.28523 of 2012 is still pending in this court, they should continue to grant such affiliation each year instead of driving the petitioner to file writ petition after writ petition into this court every year."

Note: It is noticed from the file that the institution has not shifted to permanent premises.

The Committee in its 255th Meeting held on 13th – 15th November, 2013 considered the matter, Hon'ble High Court Andhra Pradesh order dated 10-10-2013 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act, for the following:

- The institution was given recognition on 03-03-2003 in a temporary premises with a specific condition that the institution should move to a permanent premise within a period of three years i.e., on or before 03-03-2003. Even after a lapse of time period of 10 years 08 months, the management has not yet to moved/shifted to its own building.

Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 31.12.2013 and the institution has submitted its reply on 21.01.2014 stating *that the Society owned five acres of registered land which and the college building was taken lease for ten years in the year 2002. NCTE was granted recognition on 03.03.2003 under Regulation 2002 of NCTE with a condition to shift to own premises.*

Between members of the Society arose disputes in the year 2003 and the Hon'ble district Judge Court of Vizianagaram, appointed a Receiver in A.O.P No. 668/2003 to see and run the day to day affairs of the St. Mark's College of Education.

The institution had filed Arbitration O.P.No. 592 of 2008 before the Hon'ble District Judge Court of Vizianagaram and obtained Order in favour of the Society declared body on 07.02.2011. Then immediately the declared Society Body approached the University to restore the affiliation to the college from the academic year 2011-12, unfortunately could not get affiliation for that year, where as the college obtained conditional affiliation to St. Mark's College of Education for the academic year 2012-13 and also 2013-14. However the declared Society body also take measures to construct Pucca College building as per norms of NCTE, in the declared society owned land in five acres at Srirampuram Village in the period of one year and decided to approach SRC, NCTE Bangalore, seeking permission to shift the college premises by paying the inspection fee under section 17 of NCTE Act.

After long battle in the Hon'ble District Court of Vizianagaram finally Court had given Judgment in favour of the Society. The Society got suffered very much difficult in financially. In spite of all sufferings the Society passed Resolutions in its Annual General Body Meeting and sanctioned the amount for the purpose of construction of the college building and also fixed time bound to complete the construction in the end of the year 2014. The Society had given Under Taking Letter on behalf of the Society to complete all necessary thing In the end of the year 2014 as per NCTE, Regulations and Norms and also seeking permission from your authorities, by paying the Fee to shift the college to the newly constructed the building in its Society's own land at Srirampuram Village.

The Committee considered the matter, reply of the institution vide letter dated 21/01/2014, decided and advised SRO to get the following documents from the institution for Causing Inspection:

- **Certified copy of the land documents duly approved by the competent authority.**
- **Building documents i.e., Building Plan & Building Completion Certificates duly approved by the Govt. authority.**
