Accordingly, inspection of the University for B.Ed-AI (Integrated Course) was conducted on 09.10.2010.</p> <p>The SRC in its 197th meeting held on 13th-14th October 2010 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the University on 10.12.2010. The University submitted its reply on 07.01.2011.</p> <p>The SRC in its 200th meeting held on 20th-21st January, 2011, after perusal of the original file of the institution and request of the management for grant of recognition to B.Ed-AI (additional intake -50 intake), and all the relevant data including the reply to the show cause notice, has decided to refuse additional intake of students to B.Ed-AI. Further, the</p>
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committee decided to issue Show Cause Notice for the existing course based on the written reply submitted by the institution vide its letter dt. 07.01.2011. Accordingly a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 27.05.2011. The institution had submitted its reply on 29.06.2011 and 25.07.2011.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 211th meeting held on 21st-23rd September, 2011 SRC decided to cause inspection on payment of Rs. 40,000/- while preparing the minutes the decision has been recorded that continuing of the programme B.Ed integrated will be subject to the review and approval of NCTE, Head quarters. The Gandhigram Rural Institute be directed to approach the NCTE Head quarters with the detailed proposal for integrated B.Ed programme, as all such innovative programmes are to go for due/fresh consideration and approval of the NCTE Head quarters. The decision of the SRC has not yet been communicated to the institution till date.

However, on the basis of decision of SRC the inspection of the institution was conducted on 16.02.2012.

The SRC in its 224th meeting held on 14-17th June 2012, considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice.

Accordingly, Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 09.07.2012. The institution submitted its reply on 31.07.2012.

The SRC in its 233rd meeting held on 26-28th September, 2012 considered the matter and decided to communicate to the institution to approach Head Quarters for approval of norms for additional intake and for the said Course/programme (APS00929-B.Ed) – Integrated course.

Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 30.10.2012. The institution has submitted written representation on 24.12.2012.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 241st Meeting held on 29th-31st March & 1st May, 2013 and the Committee has noted the matter and closed the file of the institution for B.Ed-AI (Integrated course).

The institution has submitted affidavit on 27.01.2015 & 20.06.2015, as per regulation 2014.

The SRC in its 241st Meeting held on 29th - 31st March & 1st may, 2013 has noted the matter and closed the file of the institution for B.Ed (Integrated course).

The institution has submitted a letter dated 11.08.2015 stating as under:

“with reference to the letter cited, I wish to inform you that we got NCTE Recognition order for starting of two year M.Ed Programme from the academic session 2015-16. So far, we have not received recognition order for two year B.Ed (Integrated) Programme as per the NCTE New Regulations, 2014.

Further I bring to your kind notice that I am once again sending the copy of the affidavit and communication sent earlier to NCTE-SRC for you kind perusal and further process to send the Recognition order for Two Year B.Ed Programme.

We also assure that we will fulfill the Norms and Regulations as per the NCTE norms from time to time.

I request you to kindly issue us revised order of recognition for B.Ed Programme at the earliest possible.”

The SRC in its 292nd meeting held on 29th& 30th September 2015, the Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. They are running a 1 year B.Ed(Integrated programme approved as an innovative programme.
2. They have now to come under the 2014 Regulations. The Supreme Court has categorically ruled that no case shall be considered under earlier Regulations.
3. In the new Regulations there is no 2 year B.Ed(Integrated) programme. The 2 year B.Ed programme is a regular programme. The B.Ed(Integrated) programme is of 4 year duration.
4. If they want to come under the new Regulations, they should follow this model and apply afresh accordingly.
5. If they wish to continue with innovative programme, then again, they must make an application afresh in accordance with the current prescriptions of the NCTE. It must be clearly understood that they can not indefinitely continue to operate a programme as an innovative programme.

As per the decision of SRC a letter was sent to the institution on 09.12.2015.

The institution has submitted its written representation on 13.01.2016. SRC in its 299th meeting held on 20th-21st January 2016 considered the written representation and decided as under:-

- 1.The 5 points raised by us in our 292nd meeting were very clear and specific. The University has not properly responded to that at all.
- 2.Only 1 year Regular B.Ed programmes are given RPRO for conversion to the 2 year regular B.Ed programme. The SRC has no authority to issue RPROs for innovative programmes.
- 3.The University will be well advised to follow point (3) of our earlier decision.

Now an email received from the NCTE head quarter enclosing a letter from Gandhigram Rural Institute-Deemed University, Dindigul, Tamilnadu, the letter stated as follows:

”I wish to bring the following facts to get Revised Provisional Recognition order (RPRO) for our B.Ed. Innovative Programme.

Gandhigram Rural Institute-Deemed University (GRI-DU) is fully funded by Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt of India since 1956.

GRI-DU offered B.Ed Integrated Programme, One year duration under Innovative Teacher Education Programme recognised by NCTE-SRC from 2003 onwards (annexure 1).

GRI-DU offers M.Ed programme recognized by NCTE-SRC from 2007 onwards (annexure 2).

It is a composite institution which offers UG & PG programmes of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, PG programmes in English, Tamil, Hindi, Food Science & Nutrition and Biology along with two Teacher Education Programmes (B.Ed & M.Ed).

An Affidavit was submitted on 22.01.2015 as per communication received from NCTE-SRC (annexure 3).

As per SRO/NCTE/RD/Regulations.2014/2014/15/60878 Dt.31.12.2014 given in the Explanatory Note point No.1 and No 5, we didn't apply afresh since we are existing composite institution. (annexure 3).

In anticipation of approval we have enrolled 36 students for our B.Ed programme for the academic year 2015-16 as fresh application is not needed.

We have submitted Affidavit on 22.01.2015, and received RPRO dated 25.05.2015 for our M.Ed programme from NCTE-SRC (annexure 4).

Communication was received from NCTE Member Secretary stating that due to heavy load of work, the revised recognition orders to some Institutions have not been issued and those institutions not getting withdrawn notification or pending court case may treated as recognized accordingly we continued the B.Ed and M.Ed courses (annexure 5)

Till date, we have not received RPRO fro our B.Ed Integrated Programme under Innovative Teacher Educaiton Programme from NCTE-SRC as per our Affidavit even though we have sent reminders on 16.06.2015, 11.08.2015, 16.10.2015, 13.01.2016 & 20.01.2016. At the same time, we have received a letter dated 09.12.2015 from Regional Director, Bangalore stating that Innovative programme cannot be continued indefinitely and we have to apply afresh (annexure 6). But as the FAQ answer given by NCTE, New Delhi, existing composite Institutions need not apply afresh (annexure 7).

Minutes of 299th meeting states that SRO has no authority to issue RPRO for Innovative Programmes (annexure 8).

The respective Head of The Department and Faculty Members of GRI met many times Regional Director, SRC in person on 30.01.2015 and submitted point to point explanations for the letter dt.09.12.2015 requesting to issue RPRO for our B.Ed Programme.

As per the NCTE Delhi, available details in website under FAQ Part II for the answer of Q.No.4 we understood that No change is made in respect of B.Ed Innovative Programme as per NCTE New Regulations, 2014. (annexure 9).

Based on the above facts, I request the Chairperson, NCTE to kindly issue RPRO either for B.Ed Innovative Programme or for two year B.Ed programme from the academic year 2015-16 at your discretion."

Maximum intake capacity of an institution taking into consideration of all courses, along with additional intake, in any case, shall not exceed 300".

- Sy.Nos of building plan 103, 125 & 128 are not matching with land documents, with the Sy.Nos given as 125/37, 103/9, 103/10 & 117/20.

Under the above grounds and with reference to the totality of information collected & based on a collective application of mind, the committee decided as per NCTE Regulations 2009, to refuse and reject the application of the institution for recognition of D.El.Ed course.

Accordingly, rejection order was issued to the Institution on 23.07.2012.

Aggrieved by the rejection order of SRC, the Institution preferred an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs vide the appellate authority No.F.No.89-658/2013 Appeal/2nd Meeting-2014 dated 25.02.2014 stating that, "...*Shri Y.V.V. Viswanath, Chairman, Yalamarty College of Diploma Education,*

Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 04-02-2014. In the appeal and during personal presentation it was submitted that "the course of TPT has commenced in the year 2009 and has finished three academic years with batches for 2009-10, 2010-11, and 2011-12: the current batch has completed the course and results are awaited. For the proof of affiliation they are herewith attaching the counseling lists of the three academic years along with the results received from the State Government. Hence, three academic years have been completed. The appellant has not made any submission to the second ground of rejection relating to discrepancy in land documents".

AND WHEREAS the submission of the appeal has been delayed by one year and 29 days beyond the prescribed period of 60 days. The appellant has not given any reasons for the delay. The Council therefore decided not to condone the delay. The appeal is not admitted.

AND WHEREAS after perusal of the memorandum of appeal, affidavit, documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council decided not to condone the delay and therefore, the appeal is not admitted."

A Court order has been received from the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad on 12.05.2014. The Court order in WP MP No. 14288 of 2014 in WP No. 11324 of 2014 is stating as follows:

"The case of the petitioners is that an appeal has been preferred to the 1st respondent on 23.08.2012 by adopting the online mode. Subsequently, the hard copy of the memorandum of appeal enclosing thereto the demand draft drawn in a sum of Rs.10,000/- on Indian Overseas Bank, Kayyapalem Branch, dated 16.08.2012, has also been made available, towards appeal processing fee. On 11.06.2013, the 1st respondent referred to the appeal dated 24.08.2012, but stated that the appeal has not been submitted through online module in the prescribed format, which is mandatory, as per the Appeal Rules, 2012, and hence, the appeal is returned in original and the appeal fee has also been sent through a cheque drawn on 11.06.2013 for a sum of Rs.10,000/-. It is obvious from this communication that the 1st respondent has encased the appeal processing fee remitted by the petitioner through the demand draft drawn on Indian Overseas Bank on 16.08.2012, submitted along with the hand copy of the Appeal. On one hand, it is stated that the appeal has been submitted on 24.08.2012. But however, the claim is that it is not submitted through online module. The National Council for Teacher Education Rules, 1997 have been framed in exercise of the power available under Section 31 of the Act. Rule 10 sets out that any person aggrieved by an order made under Section 14, 15 or Section 17 of the Act may prefer an appeal in Form-I appended to these Rules. However, it appears Sub-Rule 2 has been added to Rule 10, which sets out that the appeal may be submitted electronically through online mode on the website of the NCTE along with the processing fee of Rs.10,000/-. It is, therefore, clear that preferring an appeal through electronic mode is one of the options. It is not the only option. If appeal in hard copy is submitted, it is not liable to be rejected only on that ground.

Hence, the respondents are directed to reconsider the appeal of the petitioner and communicate the decision taken thereon, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within six (6) weeks from today."

The Court order was forwarded to B.P. Pandey Under Secretary NCTE-Hqrs on 20.05.2014 (since the first respondent is NCTE-Hqrs) for taking necessary action.

On 29.05.2014, copy of the letter dated 24.05.2014 addressed to the Hqrs with a request for reconsideration of appeal application is received by this office.

A court notice in W.P. No. 11324 of 2014 dated 22.04.2014 has been received from Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh on 30.05.2014.

A letter was sent to Advocate Sri. K. Ramakanth Reddy on 10.06.2014 along with court notice to defend the case. Meanwhile, a letter has been received on 02.06.2014 from Mr. B. P. Pandey, US (Legal), NCTE Hqrs, New Delhi vide letter No. F.64-208/2012/NCTE/Legal/A88128 dated 26.05.2014 (copy enclosed) which is as under:-

"I am directed to refer to the notice dated 27.04.2014 receive from Hon'ble High Court Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad along with in the matter mentioned above. The operative part of the Court order is as under:-

"The National Council for Teacher Education Rules, 1997 have been framed in exercise of the power available under Section 31 of the Act. Rules 10 sets out that any person aggrieved by an order made under Section 14, 15 or Section 17 of the Act may prefer an appeal in Form-I appended to these Rules. However, it appears Sub-Rule 2 has been added to Rule 10, which sets out that the appeal may be submitted electronically through online mode on the website of the nccte along with the processing fee of Rs. 10,000/-. It is, therefore, clear that preferring an appeal through electronic mode is one of the options. It is not the only option. If appeal in hard copy is submitted, it is not liable to be rejected only on that ground.

Hence, the respondents are directed to reconsider the appeal of the petitioner and communicate the decision taken thereon, as expeditiously as possible, preferable within six (6) weeks from today."

2. The NCTE (Third Amend mend) Rules, 2011 come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2012 by which Rule 10 has been submitted as under:-

10(1) Any person aggrieved by a refusal order made under Section 14 or Section 15 or withdrawal order made under Section 17 of NCTE Act, may prefer an appeal in Form I or Form II appended to these Rules, to the Council within Sixty days of issue of such orders, along with a fee of Rs. 10,000/- payable on line with the submission of appeal:

Provided that an appeal may be admitted after the expiry of the said period of sixty days, if the appellatant satisfies the Council that he had sufficient cause for not preferring the appeal with the period of limitation of sixty days.

10(2) The appeal may be submitted electronically through online mode on the website of National Council for Teacher Education along with processing fee of Rs. 10,000/-. The appellatant shall download the filled in online application and post two sets of hard copies accompanied with the requisite documents, to the Member Secretary, NCTE, New Delhi within two days of online submission of the appeal.

3. It is therefore, apparent that the case has not been contested properly by the Legal Counsel of NCTE of Hyderabad High Court as "preferring an appeal through electronic mode is not one of the options" rather it is only the option to prefer an appeal. The Legal Counsel could not explain the above rule in correct prospect to the Hon'ble High Court therefore, the above order deserves to be challenged before the Division bench by filing Letter Patent Appeal (LPA) / Writ Appeal.

4. It is therefore, requested to file the LPA/AP against the order dated 27.05.2014 immediately, under intimation to this office, in order to avoid any contempt proceedings."

The SRC in its 268th meeting held on 4-5th June, 2014 considered the matter, letter dated

26.05.2014 from NCTE (H'qrs) New Delhi advising SRCNCTE to file the LPA/AP against the order dated 27.05.2014 immediately. The Committee decided and directed Southern Regional Office to ask our Lawyer to file an appeal before the Division Bench as advised by NCTE (H.Q).

As per the decision of SRC a letter was addressed to Sri. K. Ramakanth Reddy, Advocate on 16.06.2014 requesting him to file an appeal before the division bench.

Aggrieved by the rejection order of SRC, the Institution prepared an appeal to NCTE-Hqrs vide the appellate authority No.F.No.89-658/2013 Appeal/6th Meeting-2015 dated 07.08.2015 stating as follows:

"The appeal of Yalamarty College of Education, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh dt.24.08.2012 against the order of the SRC dt.23.07.2012 refusing recognition for conducting D.El.Ed course was returned to the appellant on 11.06.2013 on the ground that it was not filed through online mode in the prescribed format. The appellant filed another appeal dt.14.03.2013 online against the same order of the SRC, which was received in the Council on 20.10.2013 with a forwarding letter dt.20.10.2013. This appeal was considered by the Appeal Committee on 04.02.2014 and finding that no reasons for the delay in appeal, which is more than one year and 29 days beyond the prescribed period of 60 days, were given by the appellant, decided not to condone the delay. Therefore the appeal was not admitted and necessary order issued on 25.02.2014.

2. Sh.Y.V.V. Vishwanath, Chairman, Yalamarty College of Education, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh presented the case of the appellant institution on 27.06.2014. The Committee noted that the appellant filed a WPMP no.14288 of 2014 in WP no.11324 of 2014 before the Honb'le High Court of Judicature of Andhra Pradesh at Hyderabad and the Honb'le High Court in their order dt.22.04.2015, on the basis of the submissions of the petitioner regarding the returning of the appeal dt.24.08.2012 not submitted through online, holding that an appeal submitted in hard copy is not liable to be rejected only on that ground, directed re-consideration of the appeal and communication of the decision preferably within six weeks from 22.04.2014.

3. The Committee noted the NCTE finding that the appellant/petitioner had concealed the fact that another appeal submitted by him in March/ Oct, 2013, had not been admitted by the Council in their order dt.25.02.2014 on account of delay, has asked the SRC on 28.05.2014 and 13.06.2014 to challenge the Honb'le High Court's order dt. 22.04.2014 placing all the facts including the fact that submission of online appeal is not one of the options, rather it is the only option before them.

4. As on today there is no appeal either online or offline pending before the Council. On the other hand the matter is sub-judice. Therefore the Committee decided to await the outcome of the application to be filed by the SRC challenging the Honb'le High Court's order dt.22.04.2014.

5. A letter dated 20.04.2015 of S.R.C. addressed to NCTE was brought to the notice of Appeal Committee where is S.R.C. requested NCTE to return the original file pertaining to the institution along with instruction regarding further course of actions to be taken by S.R.C. Committee has already decided that there is no appeal either on-line or offline pending before the Council. As such there are no further direction/orders from the Committee." However, a copy of the minutes of meeting is enclosed herewith for your reference and necessary action.

In view of the above it is requested to furnish required information as indicated above within 10 days time enabling appeal committee to dispose of the appeal of the appellant institution accordingly.

The SRC in its 292nd meeting held on 29-30th Sept, 2015 the Committee considered the Court matter, Appellate Authority order dated 29.06.2015, and decided as under:

"Await further orders of the Court".

Now, the institution forwarded a copy of Hon'ble High Court order in W.P. No. 11324 of 2014 dated 13.09.2015 filed by Yalamarty College of Diploma Education, Suryabagh, Visakhapatnam-530020 stating as follows:-

ORDER : *This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the following relief :*

“ to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 1st respondent in rejecting the appeal filed by the petitioners in F.No.89-658/2013 Appeal/2nd meeting-2014 dated 25.02.2014 preferred against the orders of the 2nd respondent passed in F.No. SRCAPP1158/D.El.Ed/AP/2012-13/44136 dated 23.07.2012 rejecting the 1st petitioner's application bearing No. SRCAPP1158 for establishment of the 2nd petitioner college to impart education in Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed) course as arbitrary, illegal, vitiated by total non application of mind and violation of Article 19 (1) (g) of the constitution of India and for a consequential direction to the 1st respondent to grant recognition to the 2nd petitioner as sought in application No. SRCAPP1158 and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”

2. *Heard Smt. G.Jhansi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned standing counsel for National Council for Teacher Education appearing for the respondents.*

3. *The petitioners question the order passed by the 1st respondent on 06.02.2014 confirming the order passed by the 2nd respondent on 03.07.2013, whereby their request for approval of College for commencing D.P.Ed course was rejected. The said orders are questioned in this writ petition, primarily, in view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) Nos.4247-4248 of 2009, vide order dated 10.09.2013. The said directions read as under:-*

“ Those who are desirous of establishing teacher education colleges/institutions shall be free to make application in accordance with the new regulations. Their applications shall be decided by the competent authority keeping in view the relevant statutory provisions. All the pending applications shall also be decided in accordance with the new regulations.

The Government of India, NCTE and the implementation committee shall be free to file interlocutory applications as and when any direction is required from the Court in the matter of implementation of the recommendations made by the Verma Commission and the committee constituted vide order dated 14/ 16.05.2013.”

4. *It is not in dispute that the new regulations framed have come into force on 28.11.2014 and in terms of the aforesaid directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the respondents have to consider all pending applications as per the new regulations.*

5. *Since the impugned orders are passed considering the petitioner's request under old regulations, the order of the 1st respondent dated 06.02.2014 is set aside and the matter is remitted to the 1st respondent herein for fresh consideration and for passing appropriate orders, within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.*

6. *Accordingly, the writ petition is allowed. Miscellaneous petitions pending consideration, if any in the Writ Petition shall stand closed in consequence. No order as to costs.*

The Committee took note of the Court order, and advised Southern Regional office to:
Await Appellate Authority's orders

The Committee considered the matter, all other relevant documents of the institution and decided as under:

Clarify to the Appellate Authority that implementation of the High Court order dt. 13.09.2015 is pending at their level.

“Golden valley Educational Society, Madanapalle have applied for B.P.Ed course vide application No.SRCAPP79 pn 31.12.2012 through online application and submitted all necessary documents including the creation of Fixed Deposits. However, the initial application was rejected for the reason that the application was not submitted in Triplicate and NCTE Southern Region intimated us their decision vide letter No:SRCAPP79/2013-14/B.P.Ed/AP/2012-13/49323. We then approached the Hon’ble High court of Andhra Pradesh vide WP No:8175/2013 and filed an appeal in the High court.

The Hon’ble High Court then passed orders to NCTE to reconsider on the application with specific directions to process the application. Also please note that we are still continuing the Rs. 5 lakhs and Rs. 3 lakhs DD which were created during the application submission time along with all necessary infrastructure such as play ground, running track, Swimming facility, Good grounds for all sports and qualified staff in all subjects/groups.

Hence kindly provide us with an opportunity by reconsidering the application and process the same to enable us to use all the class rooms and other labs, huge play ground.”

When the Council informed the appellant on 27.11.2015 that the appeal was not submitted on-line and there were other deficiencies also, he did not respond.
