Central University of Tamilnadu, Neelakudi Village, Kangalancherry Post Office, Thiruvarur Taluk and City, Thiruvarur District-610101, Tamilnadu has applied for grant of recognition to Central University, Neelakudi Village, Kangalancherry Post Office, Thiruvarur Taluk and City, Thiruvarur District-610101, Tamilnadu for offering B.AB.EdB.ScB.Ed course of four years duration for the academic session 2016-17 under Section 14/15 of the NCTE Act, 1993 to the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE through online on 21/05/2015. The institution has submitted hard copy of the application on 04/06/2015.

The application is processed as per NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedures) Regulations, 2014 notified by NCTE on 01.12.2014. A letter for recommendation of State Govt. was sent on 09/6/2015 Followed by recommendation 11/12/2015 and reminder II on 15/12/2015.

The Sub Section (7) of Section 7 of Regulations, 2014 for processing of applications stipulates as under:

"After consideration of the recommendation of the State Government or on its own merits, the Regional Committee concerned shall decided that institution shall be inspected by a team of experts called visiting team with a view to assess the level of preparedness of the institution to commence the course".

The SRC in its 296th meeting held on 15th-16th December, 2015 considered the documents submitted by the institution along with hard copy of application and it has decided as under:

- 1. Name to be changed to Central University.
- 2. Ask VT to obtain relevant Land and Building documents.
- 3. Cause Composite Inspection.

As per the decision of SRC, inspection intimated was sent to the institution on 11.01.2016. The inspection of the institution was conducted on 26.01.2016 and the VT Report along with

documents received in the office of SRC on 01.02.2016.

The SRC in its 301^{st} meeting held on $05^{th} - 06^{th}$ February, 2016 the committee considered the VT report and all relevant documents and decided to issue LOI for 1 unit.

As per the decision of SRC the Letter of Intent was issued to the institution on 11.02.2016.

Now, the institution has submitted its reply for LOI on 03.03.2016 stating as follows:

The University also undertakes that "Any false or incomplete information on website shall

render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition".

The committee considered the matter, LOI reply dated 03.03.2016, all other relevant documents of the institution and decided as under

- 1. Approved staff list not yet received
- 2. They have time till mid April
- 3. Put up in the third week of April
- 4.Inform the University that the Supreme Court has prescribed 2^{nd} May as the last date for issue of Formal Recognition for 2016-17

The institution has submitted written representation on 30.04.2016 and stated as follows:

We would like to inform that the Central University of Tamilnadu. February 2016. Thiruvarur was issued a letter for starting of the BSc.BEd. course from the academic year 2016 by National Council For Teacher Educaiton, Southern Regional committee (NCTE SRC) subject to submission of list of faculty members for the said course.

To appoint teachers for the Department of Education in CUTN, We have already finished the selection process for the post of Professor/s, Associate Professor/s on 16.03.2016 and for the post of Assistant Professors on 18th, 19th and 20.04.2016.

Meanwhile the Election Commission of Tamilnadu has instructed.

CUTN to defer the selection process till the completion of the Election in Tamilnadu.

Hence, as the end of the selection process to issue offer of appointment orders to the list of selected members, approval by the Executive Council of the University becomes essential which would done only after the completion of the election code of conduct. In this context we will be able to appoint the teachers before the prescribed time and submit the staff list to NCTE only after 19th april 2016. Therefore, under the circumstance, we request the NCTE, to kindly consider our case as a special issue and grant approval pending submission of the staff list by the end of June 2016. We undertake to submit the list of staff latest by 30.06.2016.

SRC in its 313th meeting held on 02nd & 3rd May, 2016 considered the matter and the committee decided as under:

Time as requested is given subject to the understanding that this case can not now be considered for 2016-17.

Accordingly, letter was issued to the institution on 01.06.2016. The institution has submitted LOI reply on 30.06.2016 and 07.07.2016.

The committee considered the matter in its 316th meeting held on 07-08 July, 2016, written representation dated 31.07.2015 from the institution, all other relevant document of the institution and decided as under

- 1. Faculty list is in order.
- 2.Issue Formal Recognition for B.Sc.B.Ed (1 unit) w.e.f. 2017-18.

10. APS08997 M.Ed (1 Unit) Rani Channamm a University. Belagavi, Karnataka KA

Kittoor Rani Chennamma PG College, Belgaum, Karnataka

Kittoor Rani Chennamma PG College, Belgaum, Karnataka had submitted an application for starting of M.Ed. course on 11.9.2007.

After submission of essential documents, inspection was conducted on 31.07.2008. The VT report and all other related documents were placed before 162nd meeting of SRC held on 20th - 21st August, 2008 and it was decided to issue Letter of Intent/Conditional recognition.

The letter of intent was sent to the institution on 18.09.2008.

Even after the lapse of stipulated time, the institution had not submitted any reply and the matter was placed before 171st meeting of SRC held during 16-17 March 2009 which has decided to issue a Notice and Notice was served to the institution on 24.3.2009 to submit the documents before 10th April, 2009.

• The institution submitted its reply on 28.4.2009.

The matter was placed before 174th meeting of SRC held on 1.5. 2009 wherein it was decided to issue Notice. Again, a letter was sent on 9.6.2009 to submit the documents within 19.6.2009 and a reminder letter was sent on 2.7.2009 to submit the documents within 10th July, 2009.

 The institution submitted representation on 22.7.2009 stating that the Vice-Chancellor of Karnatak University, Dharwad is making appointment of teaching staff as per norms.

The matter was placed before 179th meeting of SRC held on 23rd July, 2009 wherein it was decided to serve Notice and Notice was served to the institution on 24.7.2009.

Since the institution did not submit any reply, the matter was once again placed before 180th meeting held on 29th July, 2009 wherein it was decided to permit the institution to submit the reply by 17.8.2009 and a final reminder was sent on 31.7.2009.

• The institution submitted its representation on 30th July, 2009 and 11.8.2009. The reply was considered by SRC in its 181st meeting held during 20-21 August, 2009 wherein it was decided to serve Notice to submit reply by 28th August, 2009 and notice was issued to the institution on 24.8.2009.

The institution did not submit any reply even after expiry of stipulated period and hence the matter was placed before SRC in its 182^{nd} meeting held on 31^{st} August, 2009 which came to the conclusion to refuse the recognition/withdraw the Letter of Intent OR Conditional Recognition accorded to the institution for the proposed course as per Section 14(3)(b) of NCTE Act for the following reasons:-

 The institution has not appointed requisite faculty/staff and also not submitted the staff list and affidavits as per regulations 7(9) of NCTE.

Accordingly, refusal order was issued to the institution vide Order No. F.SRO/NCTE/2008-2009/15844 dated 24.09.2009. Aggrieved by the refusal order the institution preferred an appeal before the appellate authority on 13.09.2011.

The Appellate authority on 8-12-2011 noted that

a) Karnataka University submitted an application to the SRC for grant of recognition of Kittur Rani Channamma P.G. Centre, Belgaum, Karnataka for M.Ed. course. SRC vide letter dated 18-09-2008 issued a letter of intent prior to grant of recognition under Clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations. Thereafter it issued a notice, for which the administrator of Karnataka University submitted a reply on 28-07-2009 stating that "the University is in the process of appointing qualified staff to teach M.Ed. students.

In the meanwhile, some qualified and permanent teaching staff has been transferred from Dharwad to Belgaum". Despite this reply, SRC decided to refuse recognition on the grounds as stated in Para 1 above. (b) The Council further noted Kittur Rani Channamma P.G. Centre, Belgaum was upgraded to the status of an independent University under the name "Rani Channamma University", Belgaum from 2010 onwards. The Rani Channamma University, being the successor institute of the earlier P.G. Centre, pursued the matter of M.Ed. recognition and filed an appeal. The delay caused in filing the appeal was due to upgradation of PG centre into university, which was a valid reason for condoning the delay caused in preferring the appeal. (c) The university had taken steps to appoint full complement of the faculty for teaching M.Ed. students.

The Appellate authority therefore came to the conclusion that there was adequate justification in accepting the appeal with a direction to the SRC for considering the faculty profile of the institution and for taking further decision thereafter. The institution is advised to forward a complete set of faculty profile as required under NCTE Norms, for consideration of SRC.

After perusal of documents, memorandum of appeal, affidavit, VT report and after considering oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council reached the conclusion that there was adequate ground to accept the appeal and reverse the SRC's order dated 24-09-2009 vide appellate authority order No.89-361/2011 Appeal/8th Meeting/2011/A46189 dated 04/01/2012 with a direction to the SRC for considering the faculty profile of the institution and for taking further decision thereafter. The institution is advised to forward a complete set of faculty profile as required under NCTE Norms, for consideration of SRC.

Accordingly, the appeal is accepted and the order of SRC dated 24.09.2009 is revered ."

The institution had not submitted Faculty profile to this office so far(as advised in the appeal order). The appeal committee advised the University to forward reply to the show cause notice of SRC for consideration vide its order dt. 04.01.2012.

The SRC in its 217th meeting held on 8-9 February, 2012 considered the Appellate authority order dated 04.01.2012 decided to wait for the reply from the institution till 45 days and then process the reply of the institution to the Show Cause Notice for further action.

As per the decision of 217th meeting of SRC and since 45 days is over and faculty profile is not received from the institution, the matter is once again placed before SRC for its consideration and decision. The SRC in its 221st meeting held on 19-20 April, 2012 considered the matter and decided to <u>close the file</u> of M.Ed (APS08997) course applied by Kittoor Rani Chennamma PG College, Belgaum District, Karnataka for the time being, as the institution is yet to submit the faculty profile.

In the meanwhile, on 11.5.2012, a fax is received from the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University, Vidyasangama, NH-4, PBNH, Belgavi-591156 regarding the starting of M.Ed. programme in the newly started Rani Chennamma University, Belagavi, Karnataka.

- The Registrar had stated that as per Karnataka State University Act, 2000, Rani Chennamma University Statutes for the recruitment of the teachers and the guidelines issued by the UGC and NCTE. As per the Act, the Chancellor of the University has to nominate experts in the selection committee and now the Governor has nominated the experts, the process of recruitment will start before the commencement of the next academic year 2012-2013(July, 2012). The entire recruitment process will be completed and the information to this effect will be communicated to you. Further, the Library and other facilities as per NCTE norms are being created.
- On 13.8.2012, a letter is received from the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University, Belgavi, Karnataka regarding revival of M.Ed. programme in the newly started Rani Chennamma University(copy enclosed). The Registrar had stated that he has selected One Professor, 2 Associate Professor and 3 Assistant professor have joined the University in the month of July, 2012. Copies of the office order issued to the selected candidates is produced as documentary proof. Joining report of the staff is not produced. List of non-teaching staff is also not produced.

The SRC in its 230th meeting held on 16th and 17th July, 2012 considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant documentary evidences wherein it was decided to serve Notice Under section 14 (1) of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Notice was issued to the institution on 30/08/2012 for the following:-

 The institution has not submitted staff profile in prescribed format as per NCTE norms. The institution submitted its reply by fax message on 31/08/2012.

The SRC in its 232nd meeting held on 29th – 31st August, 2012 considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Notice Under NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Notice was issued to the institution on 24/09/2012 for the following deficiency:-

 Associate Professor is not having the prescribed qualification for the post as per NCTE norms.

The institution submitted replies vide letter dated 01/10/2012 and 16.10.2012.

The SRC in its 235th meeting held on 21-22 November, 2012 considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Notice Under NCTE Act and Notice was issued on 31.12.2012. Notice issued to the institution is returned back on 07.01.2013.

In the meanwhile, on 3.1.2013(on going through the website), the Registrar submitted reply to the deficiencies pointed out

The Chairman's Remarks: In 242nd meeting

"In the context of discussion relating to Rani Chennamma PG College, Belgaum District, Karnataka, a point was raised about Prof. Lalithamma, a Member of the Southern Regional Committee, having been a member of the selection committee for Faculty in the Rani Chennamma PG College/University. It was suggested that it would be appropriate for Prof. Lalithamma to withdraw from the deliberations to avoid any issue of conflict of interest. Prof. Lalithamma was firmly of the view that there was no question of clash of interest and that it would be inappropriate to require her to recluse. But, the other members of the Southern Regional Committee attending the meeting were definitely in favour of her withdrawal especially for facilitating free and frank expression of views of all. Accordingly, Prof. Lalithamma left the meeting and withdrew from participation in the deliberations on this item".

The SRC in its 242^{nd} Meeting held on $14^{th}-16^{th}$ April 2013, considered the matter, reply of the institution dated 03.01.2013 and advised Southern Regional Office to write to University for justification of the appointment of Dr. Maruthi Rao Nimbalkar, a superannuated faculty.

Accordingly, a letter was addressed to the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University seeking justification of the appointment of Dr. Maruthi. R. Nimbalkar, a superannuated faculty.

The Registrar, Rani Chennamma University submitted a written representation dated 24.06.2013 received by this office on 02.07.2013 is as under ;-

"With reference to your letter No. F.No. APSO8997/M.Ed/KA/2013-2014/51963

dated 31.05.2013,I am to submit that Dr. Maruthi.R.Nimbalkar is not appointed in Rani Chennamma University, against any vacancy of faculty position. However he has been appointed as the visiting professor as per the Karnataka State Universities Act 2000 section 53 and subsection 10 for a period of one year.

In fact,Dr. M.R. Nimbalkar was the Principal of Kai .Sou. Indumathi Patil Mahila B.Ed College,Malakapur-Shahuwadi. With his vast administrative and teaching experience in the past he was designated to the post of Visiting Professor.

It was found imperative that a person with such experience be appointed as visiting professor to enable the newly established school of Education Department of Rani Channamma University, Belagavi.

It is further reiterated that Dr. Nimbalkar is not a regular appointed faculty of School of Education, but only a Visiting Professor of Education appointed on an adhoc basis (not against any regular post)" Photocopy of Bio-data and Experience Certificates of Dr.M.R.Nimbalkar were enclosed.

The Southern Regional Committee in its 250th meeting held on 11th – 13th August,2013 considered the reply of Registrar dated 31.5.2013 and advised the University to submit list of regular staff as per NCTE norms and standards for M.Ed.

As per the decision of SRC, a letter was sent to the institution(University) seeking the list of regular staff as per NCTE norms, vide F.SRO/NCTE / APSO8997/M.Ed /2013/53881 dated 20.09.2013

Now, on 13.08.2013, a complaint was received by this office from Mr.Basavaraj Godachi, High Court- Advocate, Gourishankara Krupa,8th cross, Kalyan Nagar, Dharwad – 580 007 which is as under :-

"It is submitted that Rani Channamma, Belgaum, Karnataka State had made the following irregularities while appointing the associate professors in department of Education;

In response to your show cause notice dated 30.08.2012,the University submitted the detailed profile of teachers appointed in the Department of Education. However the NCTE was still not satisfied with the appointments and passed a resolution in its 235th meeting held on 21st – 22nd November 2012. Following is the text of the resolution.

The Committee considered the reply of the institution and all the relevant serve Notice Under NCTE Act for the following:

- Dr. Yarriswamy is not eligible for the post of Associate Professor as he is having only 51.7% in M.A Degree, as per NCTE norms minimum of 55% Marks is required for eligibility.
- Dr. Sushma is not eligible for the post of Assistant Professor as she is having only 53% in M.A Degree, as per NCTE norms minimum of 55% Marks is required for

eligibility.

 Dr. Maruthirao. R. Nimbalkar is not eligible for the post of Visiting Professor as she is having only 52%,marks, as per NCTE norms ,minimum of 55 % marks is required for eligibility."

In view of the above and with reference to the totality of information collected & based on a collective application of mind, the Committee decided to issue a Notice to the institution, as to why the recognition be not withdrawn and thereby providing an opportunity to the institution to make a written representation within 21 days from the date of receipt of the Notice along with necessary certificates/documents in order to take a final decision in the matter; failing which action will be taken including the withdrawal of application for recognition, based on the records available, with no further notice.

However, the above NCTE observations are only partial and several irregularities have taken place while appointing the teachers in Education. The following Associate Professors appointed by the University are ineligible for their posts for the following reasons;

I. Dr. Purnima Pattanashetti

a.PG Teaching Experience

Dr.Purnima Pattanshetti has never taught in any colleges even for B.Ed course. However she has managed to collect the experience certificates from private B.Ed Colleges. She has enclosed the teaching experience of Jain Mahila Mandal's B.Ed College for women from 1989 – 1994. Where as she has completed her B.Ed in 1989 and M.Ed in 1992. she was not eligible to teach B.Ed course also from 1989 1992. She has enclosed a forged Experience Certificate issued on 29.06.1996 by the President of the Jain Mahila Mandal in order to secure Job in Rani Channamma University to make her eligible for the post of Associate Professor. The Vice Chancellor of Rani Channamma University was bent upon appointing her as Associate Professor, as she was a sitting Syndicate Member of the University till the date of her interview. Dr. Purnima Pattanshetti has produced many other testimonials to show her teaching experience as visiting teacher in PhysiotherapyNurisng colleges and residential schools which are not the requisite experience to qualify her to the post of Associate Professor.

b. Academic Performance Indicator Points (API):

Dr.Purnima Pattanshetti has claimed 450 API points to her credit and the University has assessed her API points to 325 API points .However,both the assessments are wrong for the following reasons:

Dr.Purnima Pattanshetti has hyped her API points by showing the fake consultancy projects of starting schools as Research consultancies(Examples of such certificates are enclosed) Dr.Purnima Pattanshetti has no academic contributions.

II. Dr. Yarriswamy

Dr. Yarriswamy has been appointed as Associate Professor though he does not have requisite qualification and experience:

a. Academic Qualification:

As per the observations made in the 235th Meeting of NCTE held on 21st – 22nd November 2012,Dr. Yarryswamy is not eligible for the post of Associate Professor as he has only 51.7% in M.A.Degree, whereas, as per the NCTE Norms minimum 55% marks is required for eligibility.

Now, the Vice-Chancellor has asked Dr. Yarryswamy to appear for his M.A. Degree from Karnataka State Open University and accordingly Dr. Yarryswamy has appeared for his M.A. Examination during the academic year (2012-13). Dr. Yarryswamy did not possess the required qualification on the date of his interview/appointment.

b. PG Teaching Experience :

As per the norms of UGC, one should have 5 years of PG Teaching Experience to be appointed as Associate Professor. Where as, as per NCTE norms at least eight years of teaching experience in University Department of Education or College of Education, with a minimum of three years at the M.Ed level. But, Dr. Yarryswamy has only one year of PG Teaching Experience and all other certificates are B.Ed teaching experience.

c. Academic performance Indicator Points(API):

Dr. Yarryswamy does not have any academic contribution which can fetch 300 API Points. However, the University has hyped the API Points and recruited him as Associate Professor.

The above complaint letter along with enclosures submitted by the complainant is submitted for its consideration and decision.

As per the decision of SRC, a letter was sent to the institution(University) seeking the list of regular staff as per NCTE norms, vide F.SRO/NCTE / APSO8997/M.Ed /2013/53881 dated 20.09.2013

With the above submission the University has not complied the provisions of Sec 53 (iv)(6) and (7) of the Karnataka Universities Act 2000 and Sec 14(1) of NCTE Act.

Sir, the above are the only few samples of the misdeeds of Vice Chancellor of Rani Channamma University. Almost all the appointments are irregular. Even the appointment of Prof. Shailaja as Professor and other three Assistant Professors in the Department of Education are also irregular. Some of the members of SRC are colluded with the Vice-Chancellor of Rani Channamma and trying to regularize these appointments and to grant recognition to M.Ed course conducted by the University. Prof. M.S. Lalithamma was former colleague of Vice Chancellor Prof. Ananthan at University of Mysore. She is putting her all out efforts to support him. Where fore it is

requested that, the proceedings for nullifying these appointments be initiated at the earliest. Further, direct the University to re-advertise and fill up the positions as per NCTE norms otherwise I will be forced to approach the competent court by way of Public Interest Litigation against the University and NCTE."

The Southern Regional Committee in its 253rd Meeting held between 30th September to 1st October,2014 considered the matter and noted that the institution (University) has not replied to our earlier letter dated 20-09-2013 to submit the list of regular staff as per NCTE norms.

'A specific complaint was received by this office from Mr. Basavaraj Godachi, High Court, Advocate, Gourishankara Krupa, 8th Cross, Kalyan Nagar, Dharwad – 580 007.

It is decided by the Committee and advised Southern Regional Office to send the above complaint letter to the University for their comments. If the reply from the University is not received to the complaint within 6 weeks, the Committee will be constrained to take an adverse decision in the matter.'

As per the decision of SRC, a letter was addressed to the Registrar, Rani Chennamma University, Belgaum seeking a reply with respect to the complaint by Mr.Basavaraj Godachi.on 18.12.2013.

In the mean time, the University submitted had a written representation on 25.11.2013,.The University has submitted a staff profile approved by Director,School of Education,Rani Chennamma University is submitted.The details are as under;

The Registrar, Ranichennamma University has replied to this office letter dated 18.12.2013 with respect to the complaint of Mr.Basavaraj Godachi as under;

Mr. Basavaraj Godachi has been seeking information on the appointments made to vario departments in Rani Channamma University. The University has furnished all the information sought by him as per the provisions of RTI Act. If the information supplied is inadequate, he has every right to approach the immediate appellate authority —i.e.- the Vice Chancellor of the University. It is disheartening to note that instead of approaching t Vice Chancellor, he has approached your good self with a frivolous complaint. I am, however, duty bound to reply to him as per your direction.

A. Clarification to the objection raised regarding the. eligibility of Dr. Yarriswamy for the appointment of Associate Professor of Education:

As per the UGC norms, the staff strength in each PG Department shall be in the ratio of 1:2:3 (1 Professor, 2 Associate Professors, 3 Assistant Professors). Following the roster system points prescribed by the Government of Karnataka, reservations are made for various categories. Further, the candidates are selected by the Expert Committee constituted as per the guidelines of UGC and the Statute of Rani Channamma University prepared for this purpose. The Selection Committee, discipline, recommended candidate specialized in certain areas relevant to impart teaching in Education. The Selection Committee opined that it is desirable for the Education Department to have a faculty who has specialized in Guidance, Counseling and Remedial Teaching. Based upon the API score and the performance in the interview, Dr. Yarriswamy was selected under the Category 3B. Regarding the basic qualification, the Committee noted that Dr. Yarriswamy had an additional PG Degree scoring 51.7% which fulfilled the norm laid down by NCTE earlier. At the time of interview, Dr. Yarriswamy had completed the first year of one more

[&]quot;With reference to the above I wish to state the following:

PG programme scoring 56%. The new NCTE norm prescribes that the incumbent candidate should have scored at least 55% at the PG level. Keeping in mind the Roster, the merit, the NCTE norms, Dr. Yarriswamy was selected provisionally. His probationary period has not yet been declared as he has not produced the final degree marks sheet of the additional PG programme indicating that he has scored more that 5% in the second year. The allegation made by Mr. Basavaraj Godachi is beyond truth and hence denied.

B. Clarification to the objection raised regarding the eligibility of Dr. Sushma: It is unfortunate that the complainant, being an advocate himself, is ignorant of the provisions of NCTE regarding the norms prescribed for appointments of various categoric of applicants. It is alleged that Dr. Sushma is not eligible for the post of Assistant Profess as she is having only 53% in M.A. degree where as the eligibility is 55% marks. This is a baseless allegation as the selected incumbent belongs to SC Category who has a relaxation of 5% in the eligibility marks. Her 53% of marks at the M.A. level is within the norms prescribed by NCTE and hence the allegation is baseless.

C. Clarification regarding the eligibility of Dr. Maruthirao R. Nimbalkar:
It is alleged that Dr. Maruthirao R. Nimbalkar is not eligible for the post of Visiting Profess as he is having only 52% of marks. Dr. Nimbalkar was a retired Principal of a College of Education in Bombay. Under the provision of Section 53.10 of KSU Act 2000, the Vice Chancellor may appoint an expert as a Visiting Professor without formally subjecting him the process of recruitment. Dr. Nimbalkar was appointed temporarily as a Visiting Professor for a period of one year to do the preliminary work to recommence the M. Ed. Course in the University. His services were terminated from September 1, 2013. This implies that he is not the faculty of the University. Hence the allegation made is incorrect.

D. Clarifications regarding the eligibility of Dr. Poornima Pattanashetti
Dr. Poornirna Pattanashetty was appointed as she fulfilled all the requirements as per KS Act 2000 and NCTE norms. The allegation that she has collected bogus experience certificates is devoid of truth. As per NCTE norms, an applicant will be eligible for the pos of the Associate Professor should have an experience of eight years of teaching experience of which 5 years at the UG level and 3 years at the PG level. As per the records available with us and also supplied to NCTE no objection was raised whatsoevel and the eligibility of the Dr. Poornima Pattanashetty for the post of Associate Professor.

The allegation that the Vice Chancellor of RCU was bent upon appointing Dr. Poornima Pattanashetty as the Associate Professor as she was a sitting Syndicate Member till the date of her interview is a friviolous and baseless allegation and has to be brushed aside. Regarding API scores, how is the Complainant competent to assess the quality of publications? The Scrutiny Committee, composed of the experts in the field, is only competent enough to award points, The Vice Chancellor and the Registrar have no say or role in deciding the API score. Hence the allegation has to be construed as a baseless one. Regarding the API scores of Dr. Yarriswamy, what has been stated in the above paragraph holds good here also. The rest of the allegations are subjective and opinionist Somebody being the former colleague of the Vice Chancellor being on the Selection Committee cannot vitiate objectivity of the selection process.

In view of the above, I request you to dispose the complaint of Mr. Basavaraj Godachi an take appropriate decision to recognize the M.Ed. Course of Rani Channamma University Please also advice any RTI activist to explore the formal avenues prescribed under RTI Act before approaching your office."

The above reply of the University was placed before the SRC in its 265th meeting held during 24-27 March, 2014, but the Committee did not take up the issue.

In the meantime, a Court Notice dated 4.4.2014 in 85469/2013 and 85596/2013 filed by I Subhas Yadav, Sai Nagar Last cross, Hubli against Ranichennamma University, Belgaur and 16 others wherein SRC, NCTE is the 6th respondent is received by this office on 21.4.2014. The petitioner is aggrieved by the appointment order dated 7.7.2012 issued to the 3rd respondent by the 1st respondent i.e, Rani Chennamma University, Belgaum and has prayed for quashing of the appointment orders issued to the 3rd respondent, i.e., Dr. Yerriswamy.

A letter was addressed to the advocate ,Shri.M.B.Kanavi on 29.04.2014.

On 21.08.2014, statement of objections was received from the advocate ,Shri.M.B.Kana .A letter was addressed to te advocate enclosing the objectionstatement on 04.09.2014.

On 12.02.2015, this office has received another notice in W.P.No. 85469 of 2013 – 8559/2013.A letter was addressed to the advocate ,Shri.M.B.Kanavi on 13.02.2015.

On 30.04.2015 and 27.05.2015, letters were received from the advocate seeking parawis comments in W.P.No. 108542 of 2014.A duly signed vakalatnama was sent to the advocate on 11.05.2015 and 29.05.2015.

Compaints were received from Shri.Basavaraj Goddachi on 29.05.2015 and 09.03.2015

On 28.04.2015, the institution has submitted an affidavit affirming adherence to Regulations, 2014 and has sought an intake of 50 students.

A letter was addressed to the university on 31.05.2015 stating that revised order cannot be issued .

On 20.08.2015, the institution submitted a request for issuance of revised order. A copy of the appellate authority order reversing the rejection order was enclosed.

On 05.10.2015, a copy of the reply the University to the complaint matter addressed to NCTE, New Delhi was received by this office. A letter was addressed to NCTE, New Delhi stating that NCTE has not granted recognition to Rani Chennamma University, Belgaum for offering M.Ed course and hence no action can be taken on a nonrecognized institution

On 21.12.2015, a letter was received from NCTE-Hqrs regarding closure of complaint of Basavaraj Godachi.

A letter was addressed to the advocate ,Shri.M.B.Kanavi on 18.02.2016 in respect of W.P.No. 108542 of 2014.

SRC in its 307th meeting held on 9th March, 2016 consiered the matter of non submission of reply to the Letter of Intent and decided as under:-

- "1. No reply has been received even after 2 years in spite of several reminders
- 2. Withdraw the LOI
- 3. Reject the application"

On 25.04.2016, a letter is received from the Registrar, Rani Channamma University stating as under :-

"With respect to the subject and references cited above, I hereby request you to add the Rani Channamma University name and code for M.Ed course in MIS Data .I would like to bring to your attention that, the University name and address are reflecting in NCTE,New Delhi website under the list of State Universitites offering Teacher Education Programmes (in Campus Department) at serial number 57.

In this regard, the University has also been regularly corresponding with your esteemd office, to add the name and code of the Rani Channamma University, Belagavi in the Regional Office MIS data also.

It is further reiterated that ,Rani Channamma University ,Belagavi is a state funde university and has finally complied with the norms of NCTE .Therefore , it is requested to kindly expedite the process for issue of the revised order .

We assure that, the University will adhere and take all such measures to comply with the norms stipulated by the apex body to maintain academic excellance.

Looking forward fpor your early response."

As per the decision of SRC, a Rejection order was issued to the University on 14.06.201

On 14.06.2016, the University has submitted a written representation as under :-

" I am submnitting herewith, the regular and guest faculty staff profiles for M.Ed course in Rani Channamma University, Belagavi

The academic year with 2 years M.Ed course (New Syallbus) for 2015-16 commend from August 2015. We have already into the verge of completion of seco semester The academic year shall begin from August 2016.At present, our Educati Faculty consists of One Professor ,Two Associate Professors and Three Assista Professors to comply as per the NCTE Norms .We need four more faculty to run to

two year M.Ed programme, so, four of the guest faculty names along with their profil are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal.

Hence, it is requested to continue the recognition of the department of Edcuati and approved the list of the staff presently working.

Reply to the complaint of Mr. Basavaraj Godachi with commenst to the complain letter.

(a) Dr. Purnima Pattanhetti

Dr. Purnima Pattanshetti had appeared for the interview on 24.05.2012 at Rani Channamma University, Belagavi for the post of Associate Professor in School of Education, Rani Channamma University, Belgavi. she got selected by the Board of Appointment (BOA) which is approved by the Syndicate on 07.07.2012. She received the appointment order and joined as Associate Professor on 16.07.2012

Her appointment is challenged in W.P.No. 85469/2013 (S-RES) on the file of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, Dharwad and is pending for disposal.

(b) Dr.N.C. Yarriswamy

Dr.M.C. Yarriswamy has been selected as Associate Professor in School of Edcuation ,Rani Channamma University,Belagavi by Board of Appointment (BOA) a he received appointment order on 07.07.2012 and reported to t5he duties from 14.07.2012. His appointment is challenged in W.P.No. 85469 of 2013 (S-RES) on t file of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, Dharwad and is pending for disposal.

Belongs to the category of SC and she is eligible to get relaxation of 5 % under the rules published on 18th September 2010 in GOI Gazette Part-III atserial number 3.4.1 Hence, she was considered for the post of Assistant Professor.A copy o the above ciyted Gazette is enclosed herewith as Annexure –A

(d) Dr. Marutirao NImbalkar ,is eligible to avail a relaxation under te provisiob provided under the rules published pon 18th September 2010 in GOI Gazette PART III serial number 3.5.0 i.e "elaxtio of 5 % may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D degree holders who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September 1991". A copy of which is enclosed herewith as Annexure –B

Further, Dr. Marutirao Nmbalkar has been appointed for one academic year i.e 2012-13 and he is relieved from his duties after one year.

The above points of reply are correct and valid as per records.the former Vice - Chancellor of Rani Channamma University, Belgavi and the Board of Appointmen have discharged their duties judiciously. The appointment of the **above said an**

other staff in the department are made according to the norms of UGC,NCTE at the University

Further, the name of Rani Channamma University ,Belagavi is in the list of National Council for teacher Edcuatin (NCTE),Hans Bhawan (Wing II) , 1,Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg ,New Delhi -110002 at serial number 57 of affiliatir universities .A copy of which is enclosed as Ammexure-C.

This is for your kind consideration and the needful action in the matter."

The University has submitted the following documents :-

- 1. The appellate authority order dated 04.01.2012 reversing the refusal order of SRC dat 24.09.2009.
- A copy of the Gazette Notification dated 18.09.2010 regarding appointment of teachin faculty.
- 3. A copy of the list downloaded from NCTE, website showing Rani Channamma University as Campus Department offering teaher education course.
- 4. Staff list of the University approved by the Registrar, Rani Channamma University on 19.05.2016 is submitted.

The following are observed from the file,

- 1. The institution was refused recognition vide this office order dated 24.09.2009
- 2. The appellate authority vide order dated 04.01.2012 has reversed the order appealed against (order dated 24.09.2009) and remanded to case to SRC with a direction to the University to submit a complete set of faculty profile.
- 3. SRC in its 221st meeting had decided to close the file, as reply was not received fron the

University .Later ,the university submitted representations/replies with respect to appointment of faculty which were considered by SRC in various committee meetin and

notices were issued as the replies were not satisfactory. Complaints were received against

the University with respect to appointment of teaching faculty.W.P.No.85469 of 2013 and

85596 of 2013 filed in respect of appointment of faculty is pending in the Hon'ble High Court

of Karnataka.

4. SRC in its 307th meeting held on 9th March, 2016 decided to withdraw the LOI and reject the

application as the reply has not been received even after 2 years inspite of several reminders. Rejection order is issued to the University on 14.06.2016

5. The University has submitted the approved staff list and representation on 14.06. 2016 and the same is detailed above.

The committee considered the matter in its 316th meeting held on 07-08 July,

2016, written representation dated 14.06.2016 from the institution, all other relevant document of the institution and decided as under

Rejection order has issued. The case has been formally closed. We have no power to reopen Closed cases. Advise them accordingly. If necessary, they can take recourse to the appeal process.

Madeena B.Ed College is an existing B.Ed college with an intake of 100 students operating in its own campus located at Vepalagadda Village, Sujatha Nagar, Kothagudem.

We are in receipt of New NCTE Regulations 2014 and submitted an affidavit stating that we will follow the NCTE Regulations-2014 hereafter.

The said affidavit was submitted along with a request to processing our application for the sanction of 2^{nd} Unit in the existing B.Ed program for the academic year 16-17.

In this connection, we wish to inform you that we have not received any letter from your office acknowledging the commencement of process for the grant of 2nd Unit in B.Ed course which was received by other B.Ed Colleges. Hence we request you to issue the same to enable us to go forward on this issue.

Therefore, we request you to kindly permit us to get our application processed as per the rules of NCTE and sanction of 2nd unit in the existing B.Ed course in the academic year 2016-17.

The committee considered the matter in its 316th meeting held on 07-08 July, 2016, written representation dated 05.07.2016 from the institution, all other relevant document of the institution and decided as under

- 1. There is a lost of confusion about dispatch/receipt of affidavit. Our papers are not fully in order to pin the blame on them. They have at least a Postal receipt for their dispatch. We had also entered into continuing correspondence with them in Nov. 2015 for renewal of FDRs. Even then the issue about (alleged) non-issue of RPRO was not pointed out.
- 2. They have now produced another affidavit for our record. Accept it and take it on record.
- 3. They had gone ahead with admissions in 2015-16. The affiliating University had allowed that. We should not jeopardize the careers of students so admitted. 4. Issue RPRO; and, prepare for inspection 'after' collecting the fee.

- P.D. Rajan College of Education, Pattukonampatti Post, Dharmapuri District, Pin-636905 Tamilnadu had submitted an application for B.Ed Course on 20.12.2004. The institution has granted recognition on 17.11.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students.

The institution vides its letter dtd. 20.01.2012 and 19.03.2012 has requested for change of management from MERIT Trust to P.D.Rajan Memorial Educational Society.

The institutions vide its letter dtd. 04.07.2012 has stated that "our application for permission for the change of Management of P.D.Rajan College of Education and P.D.Rajan Teacher Training Institute from Madras and Research Integrated Trust (MERIT) to P.D. Rajan Memorial Educational Society. As the academic year 2012-2013 has commenced and the Management of MERIT Trust has decided not to allow any confusion in the minds of the General Public and the students as to which Management is going to have control over P.D.R. College of Education and P.D.R Teacher Training Institute. MERIT Trust has decided to withdraw the Application submitted to NCTE (SRC), Bangalore letter dtd. 30.01.2012. Our Request for the Change of Management from MERIT Trust to P.D.Rajan Memorial Educational Society may be withdrawn.

We request that this withdrawal may be recorded and necessary orders may be issued regarding the withdrawal of our application for change of Management".

The SRC may take a note regarding withdrawal of request of change of management.

The SRC in its 230th meeting held on 16th-17th August, 2012 considered the request of the management vide their letter dt.30.01.2012 for <u>withdrawal</u> of application for change of management from MERIT Trust to "P.D. Rajan Memorial Education Society"

The institution vide its letter dtd. 13.08.2012 has submitted DD bearing no. 882651 dtd.

10.08.2012 for Rs. 50,000/- towards change of place from Pattukonampatti to Pappireddipatti, Dharmapuri District for B.Ed course and had stated the following:-

"National Council for Teacher Education(SRC) Bangalore was pleased to accord Recognition to start B.Ed course by P.D.R. College of Education at Pattukonampatti, Pappireddipatti (Po) & (Tk), Dharmapuri District with an intake of 100 students from 2005-2006.

Based on the Recognition order of NCTE (SRC), Bangalore, Periyar University granted affiliation to P.D.R. College of Education from 2005-2006.

Consequent on the formation of Tamilnadu Teacher Education University, all the colleges of Education that were earlier affiliation to different Universities within their jurisdictions in Tamilnadu, came under the unitary control of Tamilnadu Teacher Education University w.e.f. 1.7.2007.

Madras Education and Research Integrated Trust (MERIT) proposes to shift P.D.R. College of Education functioning at Pappireddipatti (Po) & (Tk), Dharmapuri District to Sekkampatti, Mobripatti Panchayat, Dharmapuri District to a permanent building. The proposed change of location of P.D.R. College of Education has a permanent Building and other infrastructure facilities as per the norms prescribed by the National Council of Education. The library and faculty members will move over to the new place.

Under Regulation 8(11) of NCTE Act, a demand draft for Rs. 50,000/- from State Bank of India, Harur, Dharmapuri District is enclosed for necessary approval after due inspection of the institution at the new site viz Sekkampatti, Mobripatti Panchayat, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District. We are willing to submit any other particulars required by NCTE(SRC).

We pray that NCTE (SRC) may be pleased to make arrangements for earlier inspection and approval for change of place of P.D.R. College of Education".

The SRC in its 233rd meeting held on 26th -28th September 2012, considered the written reply and other relevant documents submitted by the institution and decided to <u>cause composite inspection</u> for shifting at the new premises and to ascertain infrastructural and instructional facilities Under NCTE Act. Accordingly, inspection was carried out on 27.11.2012.

The SRC in its 237th meeting held on 05th -06th January, 2013 considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences of B.Ed course and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act.

Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 15.03.2013. The institution had submitted its written representation on 05.04.2013.

The SRC in its 246th meeting held on 2-6 January 2013 considered the written reply of the institution and noted that many deficiencies are still there even after grant of many opportunities for their removal, decided to reject the application for shifting.

Further, the committee considered the written reply of the institution vide letter dt.05.04.2013 on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution, the deficiencies still persists and decided to withdraw recognition for B.Ed for the following reasons:-

1. Original approved building plan issued by competent civil authority is not submitted. In

the approved building plan copy submitted, total land area is not mentioned, moreover, all the rooms shown as class rooms in the building plan, instead of specifying the rooms for Laboratory, library, Principal room, office, multipurpose hall etc., multipurpose hall size is also not mentioned.

- 2. Original FDRs of Rs. 5 & 3 lacs towards endowment and reserve fund from a Nationalized Bank in joint name is not submitted.
- 3. Notarised land usage certificate from the Revenue divisional office stating that the agriculture land converted to non-agriculture for the <u>educational purpose</u> is not submitted. Proceedings of Revenue Divisional Officer not submitted for conversion of land from agricultural to educational purposes.
- 4. For the deficiency point (14) of the show cause notice, the institution has replied that the Associate professor S. Manimizhi qualified with M.Sc & M.Ed joined on 01.06.2012 in handling foundation courses. But the name of the same lecturer is not found in the approved staff list. Qualification certificate, marks cards etc., as per Annexure I, II, & II not submitted for Lecturer in Physical Education.
- 5. Lecturer in Fine Arts is not qualified for the post as per NCTE norms.

The reply of the institution is not convincing and not satisfactory.

Based on the above grounds, the committee decides to <u>withdraw the recognition</u> of the B.Ed (APS03809) course run by P.D. Rajan College of Education and P.D.R Teacher Training Institute, Pattukonampatti Post, Dharmapuri District-636905, Tamilnadu from the academic year 2013-14, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in B.Ed course, if any, to complete their course.

Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 11.07.2013.

The institution, preferred an appeal to NCTE, Hqrs and the Appellate Authority vide order no. F.No. 89-495/2013 Appeal/15th meeting-2013/A77964/ dated 12.11.2013 has stated as follows:-

"after perusal of the documents, Memorandum of appeal, affidavit, the documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council concluded that the appeal deserves to be remanded to SRC with a direction to re-consider the explanations given by the appellant institution and till then the withdrawal order dated 11.07.2013 may be kept in abeyance. The case may be decided within two months of the receipt of the order of the Appellate Authority.

NOWTHEREFORE, the Council hereby remands back the case of P.D. Rajan College of Education, Dharmapuri, Tamilnadu to the SRC, NCTE, for necessary action as indicated above."

The SRC in its 256th meeting held on 04-06th December, 2013 considered the Appellate authority order dated 12/11/2013, directing SRC to process the application as per the regulation, decided to process and advised Southern Regional Office to put up the case in next meeting.

Accordingly, the application was being processed and placed before SRC in its 260th meeting held on 29-31 January 2014, and the committee considered the Appellate authority order dated 12/11/2013 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act for the following –

- The Institution has not appointed Lecturer in Foundation course.
- The Institution has not appointed Part-time Lecturer in Physical Education and Fine Arts.

• The Institution has not appointed Librarian.

Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 25.02.2014, notice was returned back to SRC, NCTE on 03.03.2014 and reposted on 03.03.2014. The institution has submitted its written representation on 27.03.2014.

The SRC in its 267th meeting held on 12-13 May 2014 considered the matter, written reply of the institution vide letter dated 27.03.2014 to the show cause notice issued, all the relevant documents of the institution, decided and advised Southern Regional Office to:

Ask for University's approval of the three newly appointed staff.

Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 19/06/2014. The institution was submitted its written representation on 24/07/2014 along with Colour Xerox copies of approved staff list on 24.07.2014

In the meantime, an e-mail has been received from Shri.K.Ramakrishna Reddy on 13.08.2014 along with <u>counter affidavit</u>.

A letter was sent to Shri.K.Ramakrishna Reddy <u>forwarding of signed counter affidavit on</u> 14.08.2014.

The court order in W.P.No.21670 of 2014 and MP.No.1 of 2014 dated 15.09.2014 was received from the Hon'ble High Court of Madras on 22.09.2014. the court order stating as follows:-

".....16.In view of the strict mandate, it appears that a batch of writ petitions were filed under Article 32 of the constitution, before the Supreme Court in W.P.(Civil) Nos.148, 152 and 155 of 2014, by three Colleges of Education in Punjab. The prayer in those writ petitions before the Supreme Court was for a Mandamus academic session 2014-2015. But, these writ petitions were dismissed by the Supreme Court by an Order dated 24.3.2014. Paragraph 2 of the said order reads as follows:

"It has been brought to our notices that this Court has passed orders I SLP (C) Nos. 4247-4248 of 2009, on 10th September, 2013 directing that those who are desirous of establishing Teacher Education Colleges/ Institutions shall be free to make application in accordance with the new Regulations to be framed by the NCTE and their applications shall be decided by the competent authority keeping in view the relevant statutory provisions. By the said order, this Court has further directed that all pending applications shall also be decided in accordance with the new Regulations. The new Regulations have not been finalized and by an order passed by this Court on 7th March, 2014 in IA Nos. 56-57 of 2011 filed in SLP (c) No.4247-4248 of 2009, this Court has granted extension of time till June. 2014 for the National Council for Teacher Education to revise the norms and standards of various Teacher Education programmes and codify the new Regulations. The result is the National Council for Teacher Education has time up to June. 2014 to frame the new Regulations and till the new Regulations are frames, the pending application of the petitions for recognition cannot be considered. Therefore, the consideration of the applications of the petitioner- institutions for the year 2014-2015 cannot be made by the National Council for Teacher Education before June, 2014, the academic session 2014-2015 would have commenced. We cannot, therefore, issue any direction to the National Council for Teacher Education to consider the applications of the petitioner-institutions for the academic session 2014-2015 instead of 2015-16."

Therefore, no Mandamus can be issued as prayed for by the petitioner, in the teeth of the order of the Supreme Court.

17. Hence, the writ petition is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, M.P. No. 1 of 2014 is also dismissed.

In the meantime, a private notice dated 19.09.2014 received from Shri.K.Selvaraj, Advocate received by SRC on 23.09.2014 regarding W.A.No.1278 of 2014 filed by P.D.Rajan College of Education- High Court Order. The private notice stating as follows:-

"The Hon'ble 2nd Division Bench of the High Court, Madras by order dated 19.09.2014 was pleased to serve Notice on the Standing Counsel for National Council for Teacher Education, the Respondent in the above appeal for hearing on 24.09.2014. Since the Standing Counsel did not acknowledge the receipt of the Notice on 19.09.2014, we are constrained to send this Private Notice to you in the above case for the hearing on 24.09.2014 due to urgency. Please acknowledge and enter your appearance in the above case for the hearing on 24.09.2014, failing which the case will be decided in your absence."

The matter was placed before SRC in its 273rd meeting held on 30th September & 01st October, 2016 considered the matter and decided as under;

Let the notice be received from the court. When that happens, our Lawyer can take note defend the case.

A letter received from the advocate P.R. Gopinathan on 29.10.2014. Accordingly Brief of the case was sent on 29.10.2014.

On 31.12.2014, a letters were issued to all existing institutions regarding notification of new Regulations 2014 seeking consent on their willingness for fulfilling the revised norms and standards before 31.10.2015.

The institution has not submitted the affidavit for offering B.Ed course.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 294th meeting held on 14th to 16th November, 2015 and the committee considered the matter and decided to *issue SCN for withdrawal of recognition under NCTE act.*

Accordingly SCN was issued to the institution on 20.05.2016.

Now, a Court order dated 30.03.2016 received on 13.05.2016 from the Hon'ble High Court of Madras in W.P.No1278 of 2014 and M.P.No.1 of 2014 filed by P.D. Rajan College of Education.

The Court order stated as follows;

The learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission of this court to withdraw this writ appeal and has also made an endorsement to that effect as under;

"The appellant may be permitted to withdraw W.A.No.1278 of 2014."

In view of the above submission and endorsement made by the learned counsel for the appellant, this writ appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Connected Miscellaneous petition is closed.

The committee considered the matter in its 316th meeting held on 07-08 July, 2016, Court order dated 30.03.2016, all other relevant document of the institution and decided as under

- 1. The court has dismissed the WP. The College has Suo Motu withdrawn the writ appeal they had filed.
- 2. This is an existing institution. They were required to file an affidavit about adhering to the 2014 Regulations so that a R.P.r.O could be issued. They have not replied to the Show Cause Notice issued thereafter by us.
- 3. Withdraw recognition for B.Ed (2 units) w.e.f. 2016-17
- 4.Inform the Affiliating University. Ask them not to allow admissions in 2016-17. 5.Students admitted in 2015-16 will be allowed to complete their course in 2016-17.

Alamelu Ammal Educational Trust, Nagapattinam, Tamilnadu for offering Andavar Teacher Training Institute, First Beach Line Road, Nagapattinam – 611001, Tamilnadu for D.T.Ed course vide order No.F.SRO/NCTE/TN-Al/2004-05/9300 dated 13.12.2004 with an intake of 100 students.

The institution had submitted proposal for shifting the premises along with Demand Draft for Rs.40,000/- vide receipt No.13293 dated 24.10.2007. The inspection report was placed before SRC in its 177th meeting held on 22-23 June 2009.

SRC considered the report and decided to issued section 17 notice. As per the decision of SRC notice was issued to the institution on 16.07.2009. In reply to the notice institution has submitted written representation on 10.08.2009.

The committee considered the reply to the Notice along with supporting documents and decided to permit the institution for shifting of D.T.Ed course from temporary premises on 15.09.2009.

Now, a Court order received from the Hon'ble High Court Of Madras dated 29.03.2016 received on 20.05.2016 in W.P.No.22532 of 2003 filed by Andavar Teacher Training Institute.

The Court order stated as follows:

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions, made on endorsement stating that this writ petition has become infructuous.

In view of the same, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs.

The committee considered the matter in its 316th meeting held on 07-08 July, 2016, Court Order dated 29.03.2016 from the institution, all other relevant document of the institution and decided as under:

- 1. The Court has dismissed the petition and closed the case.
- 2.The Court Order is noted.
- 3. The facts of this case are, however, not clear. The objection raised was stayed by an interim injunction. What happed to the injunction. If it is deemed to have abated, what happens to our objection?
- 4.Let us undertake a fresh review of this case.

Ponnaiah Ramajayam College of Education, P.R. Group of Institutions, Central Office, M.C. Road, Natarajapuram South, Thanjavur-613007, Tamilnadu had submitted an application for B.Ed and M.Ed Course. The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed Course (APS03278) on 14.11.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students, M.Ed Course (APS07646) on 07.11.2007 with an annual intake of 35 students, M.Ed Course (APS07649) on 06.11.2007 with an annual intake of 25 students and P. R College of Education, PR Engineering College Campus, Vallam, Thanjavur-613403, Tamilnadu was granted recognition for B.Ed Course (APS00936) on 12.04.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students P. R College of Education, SR No. 99/2, 100/1B, 1E, 1D, Thiripu Village, Kumbakonam, Thanjavur – 614904, Tamilnadu was granted recognition for B.Ed Course(APS04432) on 22.09.2008 with an annual intake of 100 students.

The institution vide its letter dated 18.09.2007 submitted vide DD bearing no. 754538 dtd. 10.09.2007 for Rs. 40,000/- B.Ed (APS00936) towards shifting of premises, Accordingly, inspection of the institution was conducted on 03.06.2011 for B.Ed (APS03278), M.Ed (APS07646) and M.Ed (APS07649) Courses and 04.06.2011 for B.Ed (APS04432) course.

The SRC in its 211th meeting held on 21st-23rd September, 2011 considered the VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution (APS04432-B.Ed. on 29.11.2011) on 22.11.2011. The institution had submitted its written representation on 26.12.2011.

The SRC in its 216th meeting held on 11th-12th January, 2012 considered the reply of the institution dt. 26.12.2011, VT report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution (APS04432-B.Ed. on 25.02.2012, APS07649-M.Ed. on 14.03.2012) on 27.02.2012. The institution had submitted its written representation on 14.03.2012.

The SRC in its 222nd meeting held on 09th-10th May 2012 considered the written reply vide letter dt 14.03.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of N CTE Act. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the

institution (APS04432-B.Ed. on 06.06.2012, APS07649-M.Ed. on 06.06.2012) on 09.06.2012. The institution had submitted its written representation on 02.07.2012.

The SRC in its 236th meeting held on 16th – 18th December 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 02.07.2012 and all the relevant documentary evidences and it was decided to serve Show cause Notice under NCTE Act, for the following:

- 1. As per land documents, only three sy. nos. viz 338/2, 337 and 340/2 consist of land area of 5.60 acres whereas as per affidavit(s) submitted by the institution, Four sy. nos viz 338/2, 337, 340/2 and 553/1B2 consist land area of 5.60 acres. It may be clarified by the institution. No land documents have been submitted for the sy. no. 553/1B2.
- 2. Sl. No. 5 of the affidavit is not as per prescribed format.
- 3. Original certified land documents are not submitted by the institution so for.
- **4.** Building Plan is not in the name of running institution, it is the name of Trust. Total site area is not mentioned therein. Moreover, built-up area is not matching with BCC.
- **5.** Building Completion Certificate is not submitted in the prescribed format and not approved by the Competent Civil Authority.
- 6. The same land and other documents have been submitted for file no. APS03278, APS07649, APS07646 and APS00936.

Accordingly, a show cause notices was issued to the institution APS00936-B.Ed, APS07646-M.Ed. on 05.02.2013, and APS03278-B.Ed, APS0-7649-M.Ed on 13.02.2013, APS04432-B.Ed on 15.02.2013. Till date the institution has not submitted written representation to the Show Cause Notice.

In the meantime, a letter from Sri.A.Sivaji, Advocate dt. 03.01.2014 received by SRC on 07.01.2014 along with court case in W.P.No.10670 of 2012 filed by Ponnaiyah Ramajayam College of Education, Thanjavur District.

Accordingly, a letter was sent to Sri.A.Sivaji, Advocate on 06.02.2014 along with brief of the case of all courses to defend the case on behalf of the SRC-NCTE.

A court notice was received on 20.03.2014 in W.P.No.10670 of 2012, the same (reminder-I) was sent to advocate on 10.07.2014 regarding the latest position of the court case.

No reply was received from the advocate so far.

In the meantime, a RTI application was received by SRC on 21.07.2014, at that time after verification of file, it is observed that the institution has not submitted reply to show cause notice issued to all the courses.

The SRC in its 273rd meeting held on 30th September and 1st October, 2014 considered the Non-reply of the institution on the above five matter and also the relevant documents of the institution and decided to withdraw recognition of all 5 courses for the following reasons:-

- No reply has been received to the Show Cause Notice issued by us vide dated 05.02.2013 (APS00936-B.Ed), 13.02.2013 (APS03278-B.ED), 15.02.2013 (APS04432-B.Ed), 05.02.2013 (APS07646-M.Ed) & 13.02.2013 (APS0-M.Ed)
- Based on the above points the committee decides to withdraw the recognition of all the 5 courses (APS0O936-B.Ed), 13.02.2013 (APS03278-B.ED), 15.02.2013 (APS04432-B.Ed), 05.02.2013 (APS07646-M.Ed) & 13.02.2013 (APS0-M.Ed) run by the Ponnaiah Ramajayam College of Education, SR No.99/2,100/1B, 1E,1D. Thiripu Village, Kumbakonam, Thanjavur-614904, Tamilndu, from the academic year 2015-16, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in B.Ed, course, if any, to complete their course.

But it is made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order.

The Affiliating body / Examining board / body be informed accordingly.

Further decided to return Endowment funds and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore, if any, after ensuring payments to all dues of faculty and staff.

Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 25.11.2014 (for all the courses i.e. B.Ed, B.Ed & M.Ed, M.Ed).

In the meantime, the institution was submitted its written representation on 29.12.2014 along with interim order in M.P.(MD) No.1 of 2014 in WP (MD) No.20239 of 2014 dated 12.12.2014. Interim order stating as follows:-

ORDER: this petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s.V.Bharathidasan, Advocate for the petitioner, the court made the following order:-

Notice to the respondents returnable in four weeks.

- 2. The petitioner has challenged the impugned order, dated 25.11.2014, passed by the second respondent/Regional Director, National Council for Teacher Education, Southern Regional Committee, Bangalore, on the ground that without due application of mind, the second respondent, wrongly holding that the petitioner has not given reply to the show cause notices, 05.02.2013, 13.02.2013 and 15.02.2013 passed the impugned order.
- 3. According to the petitioner, he has sent a common reply in respect of all the show cause notices on 25.03.2013 seeking for personal hearing for production of the required documents to satisfy the second respondent. In spite of the fact that the petitioner has sent a detailed representation through registered post, which was received by the second respondent, on 03.04.2013, the impugned order repeatedly says that no reply has been submitted by the petitioner to the show cause notices, dated 05.02.2013, 13.02.2013 and 15.02.2013.
- 4. On perusal of the records, it is seen that the petitioner has submitted his detailed and comprehensive reply on 25.03.2013, along with relevant documents to the said show

cause notices. In such circumstances, this court deems fit to stay the operation of the impugned order dated 25.11.2014, passed by the second respondent. Accordingly, an order of interim stay is granted.

- (Note: (1) Outcome of the court case in W.P.No.10670 of 2012 is not known by SRC.
 - (2) As state in the order, the institution has not at all submitted reply on 03.04.2013 as per this office center diary report (copy enclosed).
 - (3)Original Interim order not received from the court.)

The SRC in its 276th meeting held on 7-9 January 2015 considered the matter, written representation from the institution vide letter dated 29.12.2014 and interim order of Hon'ble High Court of Tamilnadu dated 12.12.2014, decided as under:

That SRO should ask the party to produce any ack. that they may have for our verification. If the ack. Is found to be acceptable, we can proceed to process the case. Otherwise, we can ask our Lawyer to move for vacation of the Interim Stay granted.

As per decision of SRC, a letter was sent to institution on 30.01.2015 and a letter was sent to advocate on 30.01.2015.

The institution has submitted its written representation on 10.02.2015. The institution has submitted photocopy of submission copies to NCTE as follows:-

The institution has submitted five original affidavit (for each course) regarding processing of application as per new regulations 2014.

SRC in its 281st meeting held on 19, February, 2015 considered the institution written representation and decided as under:

- 1. Our records do not show receipt of any reply dated 25.3.2013
- 2. They have also not shown any such document to us or to our Lawyer in spite of repeated

reminders.

3.Ask our Lawyer to appraise the Court of this position and move for vacation of stay and dismissal of the petition.

As per decision of SRC, a letter was sent to Advocate on 17.03.2015.

Revised Recognition order was issued to the institution APS00936-B.Ed with an intake of 100 students, APS04432-B.Ed with an intake of 100 students, APS07646 (M.Ed) with an intake of 50 students, APS07649 (M.Ed) with an intake of 50 students, APS03278 (B.Ed) with an intake of 100 students on 31.05.2015 with a condition that the SRC has withdrawn recognition on 25.11.2014 and Hon'ble High Court of Madras has ordered an interim stay of the withdrawal orders in MP (MD) No.1 of 2014 in W.P.No.20239/2014.

A letter received from the advocate A.Sivaji on 09.05.2016 requesting to send history of the case & para war remarks in respect of W.P.No.10670 of 2012 filed by PRIST University.

Accordingly the brief of the case was sent on 10.05.2016.

Now, a Court order received from the advocate in W.P.No.24939 of 2005 and W.P.M.P.No. 27314 of 2005.

The Hon'ble Court order in W.P. No. 24939 of 2005 and W.P.M.P. No. 27314 of 2005 dated 29.10.2013 stating as follows; "......The NCTE Act has been enacted by Parliament under entry 66 of list 1 to coordinate with and determine the standards of teacher training institutions as well as entry 25 of List III. The provisions of the University Act regarding affiliation of teacher training colleges and the conditions for grant and continuation of such affiliation by the University shall remain operative. However, the conditions that are prescribed by the University for grant and continuation will have to be in conformity with the norms and guidelines prescribed by the NCTE in respect of the matters entrusted to it under the NCTE Act. We hasten to add that the grant of affiliation alone entitles the colleges to admit the students and also enables the students to write the examination, subject to the training in the prescribed syllabi and fulfilling the attendance norms, and there cannot be any retrospective affiliation and the attendance before the affiliation or college is entitled to admit students before the grant of affiliation by the University, and as observed by the learned Chief Justice in Loordhu Ammal Educational Trust's case, that any college or institution admitting students for a degree in the University even before the University accords affiliation is really committing fraud on those students and is cheating those students who are given admission, because those students can be left in the add that it would be impermissible for the court to permit the students of an unaffiliated institution to appear for the examination conducted by the University under the interim orders of the court or to direct the University to grant affiliation with retrospective effect, as it would amount to directing the University to disobey the statute to which it owe its existence and the regulations made by the University itself".

- 6. Admittedly, the fourth respondent college was not affiliated at the relevant point of time and therefore, as per the decision of the Hon'ble Full Bench of this court, the petitioners are not entitled to seek the relief as prayed for in this writ petition.
- 7. Therefore, the writ petition is dismissed by following the above referred decision of the Hon'ble Full Bench of this Court. No. Costs. Consequently, connected Micellaneous Petition is closed.

The Committee in its 315th src meeting held on 17-18 June, 2016 considered the

matter, Court order, other related relevant documents of the institution, and decided as under;

On 15.03.2010 a letter is received by this office from the institution regarding change in the nam of the college as under:-

"I have the honour to inform you that, The Board of Management, K.L.E Society, Belgaur at its meeting held on 26th September,2009 resolved to name the K.L.E Society's College of Education (B.Ed), Athani as "K.L.E Society's Smt. Yashodadevi Gangadha Kulagude College of Education (B.Ed), Athani"

Hence, I request you to kindly change our college name in all your correspondence a "K.L.E Society's Smt, Yashodadevi gangadhar Kulagude college of Education (B.Ed, Athani"

This is for your kind information and necessary action in the matter."

The SRC in its 190th meeting held during 29th & 30th March,2016 Considered the request of the institution and has permitted for change of name from K.L.E Society's Smt. Yashodadev Gangadhar Kulagude college of Education (B.Ed), Athani" on payment of Rs.40,000/- by the institution and subject to the condition that there is no change in the location and the Management.

As per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 07.05.2010 requesting to submit Rs.40,000/- towards change of name. Now the institution has submitted Demand Draft bearing No.265011 dated 20.05.2010 for Rs.40,000/- on 25.05.2010.

The SRC in its 195th meeting held during 17th & 18th August,2010 considered the request of the institution and permitted to change the ane of the college from. K.L.E Society's college of Education to K.L.E society's Smy Yashodadevi Gangadhar Kulagude college of Education (B.Ed Athani" Subject to the Condition that there is no change in the Management.

As per the decision of SRC, order was issued to the institution on 29.09.2010 regarding change

of name of the college.

On 31.12.2014 a letter was issued to the institution on affidavit expressing adherence to Regulation 2014. The institution has submitted its written representation along with affidavit on 30.01.2015.

The Provisional revised order issued to the institution on **18.05.2015** with an intake of 100 Students with shifting condition

On 25.06.2015 a letter is received by this office from the institution as under:-

"I have the honour to invite—your kind attention that, we have received your letter of 22.05.2015. As per clause No.3 mentioned in your letter No.65085 dated 18.05.2015, is found that our institution has not shifted to our own premises.
