

**Consideration of Vt reports, SCN reply, Request for one unit and request for Postponement of inspection: (Volume-2)**

49	APS00206 B.Ed-2 Units Priyanka College of Education, Prakasam, Andhra Pradesh AP	<p><b>Priyanka College of Education, Ongole Revenue division, Near Prathibha Junior College, Kurnool Road, Ongole, Prakasam dist- 523 001, Andhra Pradesh.</b></p> <p>Vivekananda Educational Society, Kandukur, Prakasam District-523105, Andhra Pradesh submitted an application for grant of recognition for B.Ed Course and recognition was granted to the Institution vide SRC order dt. 03.03.2003 at Priyanka College of Education, Ongole Revenue division, Near Prathibha Junior College, Kurnool Road, Ongole, Prakasam dist- 523 001, Andhra Pradesh (As per recognition order with a condition to shift the institution to permanent premises). The institution was accorded recognition in the rented premises and had not shifted to its own building.</p> <p>The matter was placed in 178<sup>th</sup> meeting of SRC held on 13<sup>th</sup> -14<sup>th</sup> July, 2009, wherein the Committee observed from records of the institution that the institution was accorded recognition in the rented premises and they had not yet shifted to the permanent premises/building. In view of non-shifting of colleges to permanent building the committee decided to issue show cause notice under section 17 of NCTE Act and obtain shifting fees and other documents for causing inspection for shifting. As per direction of Regional Committee, Show Cause Notice was issued with request to submit following documents within 21 days of receipt of letter.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Demand Draft of Rs.40000/- towards inspection fee in favour of “The Member Secretary, NCTE” payable at Bangalore should be submitted.</li><li>2. Land documents of the new building/location for having own land in the name of the institution /Society/Trust.</li><li>3. Building plan of the new building duly approved by the Government authority.</li><li>4. Building Completion Certificate from the Government authorities in the prescribed format (Format enclosed).</li><li>5. Land Usage Certificate from the concerned Government authorities stating that the land is exclusively permitted / sanctioned for Educational Purposes only should be submitted.</li><li>6. Encumbrance certificate from the competent Government should be submitted</li><li>7. Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs.5 lakhs kept in <u>JOINT ACCOUNT</u> with SRC in Nationalised Bank for a period of 5 years towards Endowment fund in <u>ORIGINAL</u> should be submitted.</li><li>8. Fixed Deposit Receipt of Rs.3 lakhs kept in <u>JOINT ACCOUNT</u> with SRC in Nationalised Bank for a period of 5 years towards Reserve fund in <u>ORIGINAL</u> should be submitted.</li><li>9. Certificate of Registration / Bye-law of the Society/Trust should be submitted.</li><li>10. The affidavit in Rs. 100/- stamp paper in the prescribed format with Notary attestation should be submitted regarding land and building.</li></ol> <p>As per perusal of the files the institutions as per statement institutions have not submitted reply even after lapse of more than one year. In first instant the list of the institutions who have not submitted reply</p> <p>The SRC in its 201<sup>st</sup> Meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2011, considered the matter and decided to withdraw recognition of Priyanka College of Education, Ongole Revenue division, Near Prathibha Junior College, Kurnool Road, Ongole, Prakasam dist- 523 001, Andhra Pradesh. (S. Sathyam) Chairman</p> <p>Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 07.04.2011.</p>

Issue a revised provisional recognition order for a two year B.Ed programme that one basic unit of 100 is changed to two basic units of 50 each. In the same order request them to ensure compliance of the new norms &amp; standards before 31 October, 2015 and seek confirmation of recognition from SRC.</li></ul> <p>Accordingly, as per the Regulation 2014, a revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 27.04.2015, with an annual intake of two basic units of 50 students each.</p> <p>The SRC in its 314<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> May 2016 decided as under:</p> <p>For cases of B.Ed (2 Units) in the existing institution, where RPRO, has been issued, we have to cause inspection to check adherence to the 2014 Regulations. This action will have to be completed by July 2016 so that revised Formal Recognition can be issued w.e.f. 2016-17 to enable them to make admission in time.</p> <p>Action to check the documents in these cases (about 1885 in number) will take time. Instead of Waiting for that action to be completed for placing them before the SRC, to save time, VT Inspections can straightaway be ordered. VT Inspection Report can be considered along with examination of the documents.</p> <p>Regional Director is authorized to initiate action accordingly. The institution concerned may be alerted about such action so that they will be prepared to receive the Visiting Teams. They may also be advised to keep in readiness latest approved Faculty Lists for Submission to the VTs.</p> <p>Accordingly, inspection intimation was sent to the institution on 14.06.2016. The names of VT members were generated online and inspection during the period 06.10.2016 to 26.10.2016 was fixed. College, Mysore regarding mis-management of the funds collected as fees from the students without providing basic amenities. An inspection of the institution was conducted and based on the report of the Visiting team, the Committee in its 193<sup>rd</sup> meeting held on 21-22 June, 2010 decided to withdraw recognition of the institution for B.Ed. course and Withdrawal order was issued to the institution vide order No.F.SRO/NCTE/2010-2011/20051 dated 28.07.2010.</p> <p><i>Aggrieved by the withdrawal order, the institution without preferring an appeal approached the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka vide W.P.No.26012 of 2010 filed by Sunitha Mahila Mandali.</i></p> <p>A notice was received from the Hon'ble Court in the above Writ petition on 09.09.2010. A letter was addressed to the Advocate on 14.09.2010 along with brief of the institution for defending the case. But, on 8.12.2010, the institution produced a copy of the stay order and requested RD, SRC, NCTE to give direction to CAC for admission of students.</p> <p>On 15.12.2010, this office issued a letter to the Special Officer for admission of students in lieu of stay order of Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka. A letter was also addressed to the Advocate on 22.12.2010 duly signing the statement of objections and affidavit for filing before the Hon'ble Court. On January 5, 2011, another letter was addressed to the advocate enclosing the documents for filing statement of objections.</p> <p>On 28.02.2012, a complaint was received from Sri. M.C. Chikkanna, Ex-Member of Corporation, Governing Council Member, Gurukul B.Ed. College, Mysore alleging that the institution is offering not only B.Ed. course, but also Nursing course and that whenever inspection team is arriving, suitable arrangements were made by putting different boards at the same place and requested to conduct an enquiry as to how the institution is running many courses at the same place without providing proper infrastructure.</p> <p>On 14.09.2012, another complaint was received from Sri.M.C.Chikkanna, Member, College Governing Council stating that <i>" Gurukul B.Ed College is running by violating the rules and regulations laid down by the government ,NCTE and Mysore University. Gurukul B.Ed College has permission for admission of 100 students. The college does not have the class rooms to accommodate 100 students. Library, Labs and computers are not available. On the whole the college does not have basic infrastructure for running the college. But still the college is running the B.Ed course. This only shows that the management officials are corrupt and the college is running owing to political pressure.</i></p> <p style="text-align: right;">Admission to Gurukul B.Ed College can be obtained in two ways. (S. Sathyam) Chairman</p> <p><i>Students who pay the amount mentioned by the management authorities without asking for a receipt for the paid amount and questioning the misdeeds</i></p>

Bharathiar University, Department of Physical Education, Maruthamalai Road, Coimbatore-641046, Tamilnadu had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for M.P.Ed course of Two years duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 30 students.

The institution was granted recognition on 13.07.2005 with a condition to shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).

Two RTI applications were received from Ms. G. Hemalatha, Advocate on 14.07.2014. RTI reply was sent to Ms. G. Hemalatha on 18.08.2014.

A complaint dated 09.09.2014 from Ms. G. Hemalatha was received by SRC on 11.09.2014 regarding appointment of Dr.K.Murugavel, Bharathiar University – Professor /Director in Physical Education in the year 2008 – Violation of NCTE / UGC norms by Bharathiar University-Coimbatore – Tamilnadu –Lodging complaint.

Again, another complaint dated 09.09.2014 from Dr. B. Navaneethan, Director of Physical Education, PSG College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore was received by SRC on 12.09.2014 regarding Dr.K.Murugavel's Appointment as Professor/Director in the year 2008-Violation of NCTE norms.

Letters were sent to Dr.B.Navaneethan and Ms.G.Hemalatha on 23.09.2014 for veracity of the complaint letter asking them to submit an affidavit and information.

An affidavit was received by SRC on 07.10.2014 from Dr.B.Navaneethan stating as follows:-

“...The brief facts are that in response to an advertisement issued in 2007 as aforesaid, Dr.K.Murugavel was appointed as Professor/Director in the year 2008 in Bharathiar University.

Dr.K.Murugavel's appointment was contrary to statutory rules as he did not have the requisite qualifications as prescribed by NCTE/UGC norms.

VIOLETION OF RULES & REGULATIONS WHILE APPOINTING, DR.K.MURUGAVEL AS A PROFESSOR/DIRECTOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION IN BHARATHIAR UNIVERSITY (FOR THE PROFESSOR POST).

a) He had no experience in Post Graduate (PG) teaching experience 10 years) in a training college (NCTE norms 2007).

b) He had no experience in Research at the AyyanadrJanakiammal College of Arts & Science, Sivakasi.

i. He worked as a Lecturer in B.Sc Physical Education, Health Education and Sports in Arts & Science College. (His experience as a UG Lecturer from 19.12.1990 to 23.04.2008. 17 years and 4 months).

Sri Vijaya Sangama Shikshana Mattu Grameena Abhivridhi Samsthe, Hosadurga, Chitradurga District, Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Sri Vijaya Sangama Shikshana Mahavidyalaya, V.V Mutt, V.V.Mutt Road, hosadurga Taluk, Chitradurga District-577527, Karnataka for Secondary (B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-06 with an annual intake of 100 students and was granted recognition on 15.03.2006 with a condition to shift to its own premises/ building within three years from the date of recognition ( in case the course is started in rented premises).

On 22.01.2015, an affidavit was received from the institution for adherence of Regulations, 2014. Revised order was issued to the institution on 29.05.2015 with an intake of two basic units of 50 students each. The institution submitted staff list pertaining to Sri Vijaya Sangama B.Ed College through an e-mail on 03.06.2015.

The institution submitted representation along with the documents to this office on 31.07.2015 & 04.11.2015. with a request for one unit of 50 only for B.Ed course.

The SRC in its 315<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2016 considered the shifting case and decided to show cause notice under NCTE Act for the following deficiencies:

1. The land document presented by them shows that the land at the new site is on Private lease which is not permissible.
2. They can not also continue at the old place because that is also a rented accommodation.
3. Shifting can not, therefore be permitted.

As per decision of SRC, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 27.06.2016.

On 08.08.2016, the institution has submitted reply to the show cause notice is as under:

As there were deficiencies pointed out in the inspection report, NCTE, Hqrs requested SRC to look into the matter in order to ascertain the compliance/ adherence of the NCTE Norms and Standards by the institution and also to take appropriate action.</p> <p>The Committee in its 208<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> July 2011 considered the VT report and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act for the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The website is not functioning.</li><li>• The earmarked Built up area for each course B.Ed(APS07276), D.Ed (APS08462) &amp; D.Ed-AI (APS08809) is to be given.</li></ul> <p>Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 30.08.2011 and the institution replied vide letter dt. 30.08.2011.</p> <p>The SRC in its 215<sup>th</sup> meeting held during 12<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 considered the reply of the institution dt. 03.11.2011 and decided to <b>continue the recognition</b> for all the courses - D.Ed (APS08462), B.Ed (APS07276) &amp; D.Ed-AI (APS08809) accorded to the institution.</p> <p>As per the decision of SRC, order for continuation of recognition was issued to the institution on 13.02.2012.</p> <p><b>On</b> 03.02.2015, the institution submitted an affidavit for offering B.Ed course with an intake of 100 students and revised order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 with an intake of two units of 50 students each. The SRC in its 317<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> July 2016 considered the matter and decided as under:

- 1.They have challenged the RPRO to say, there can be no shifting condition since they have all along been operating on their own land/building.
- 2.1.This claim is not sustainable. The original V.T. Inspection Report clearly states that they would start in a rented building and in 1 ½ years time shift into a new building under construction on their own land.
- 2.2.The original recognition order had also referred to a need to shift in case the course was started in a rented building.
- 3.Their claim is, therefore, rejected. Issue Show Cause Notice for withdrawal of recognition.

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution submitted on 15.09.2016.

The institution submitted written representation on 10.10.2016, as under:

*We furnish herewith the required profarma particulars along with CD in the form of soft copy together with DD No.079955 dated 04.09.2007 for Rs.40,000/-drawn in favour of Member Secretary, NCTE, Bangalore as desired.*

*We request you to acknowledge the receipt of the above at an early date.”*

A letter was issued to the institution on 26.05.2009 for submitting Proposal for shifting the institution to its permanent building.

Further there is no action in the file.

The institution submitted its willingness affidavit on 04.02.2015 for compliance of Regulations, 2014. Accordingly, revised recognition order was issued to the institution on 14.05.2015 with an intake of 100 students (2 units of 50 students each) with a condition that the institution has not shifted to its own premises as stipulated in its formal recognition order dated 04.04.2003.

The institution submitted its written representation on 16.06.2015 along with relevant documents stating as follows:
