The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed course on 02.11.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students and for M.Ed course on 13.07.2007 with an annual intake of 25 students. As per direction of NCTE, the intake of M.Ed course was increased from 25 to 35 vide order dt. 01.09.2010, with the condition to shift to own premises within 3 years.</u></p> <p>The management is running B.Ed & M.Ed courses in the same building.</p> <p><u>The institution vide its letter dated 24.04.2009 submitted Rs. 40,000/- for shifting of premises.</u> Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was fixed between 18th-23rd April 2011. The same was intimated to the institution on 12.04.2011. <u>Accordingly, shifting inspection of the institution was conducted on 22.04.2011.</u></p> <p>The SRC in its 205th meeting held on 18th-19th May, 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show Cause Notice for all the Four courses under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a show cause notice was issued to the institution on 27.06.2011. The institution submitted its reply on 27.07.2011</p> <p>The SRC in its 211th meeting held on 21st-23rd September, 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Final Show Cause Notice under Section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Final Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 15.11.2011. The institution submitted its written representation on 14.12.2011.</p> <p>The SRC in its 216th meeting held on 11th-12th January, 2012 considered the written reply of the institution vide letter dt. 14.12.2011 on the above matter and also the relevant documents of the institution and noted that the deficiencies still persist and decided to <u>withdraw recognition of all the four courses</u> for the following reasons:-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Documentary proof is not submitted to show the registered land document in the name of Society, for the survey numbers where the institution is located. 2. The earmarked Built up area for each course D.T.Ed, D.T.Ed-AI & B.Ed & M.Ed course not submitted. 3. Building completion certificate in the prescribed format from competent authorized Government engineer is not submitted. 4. The institution in its reply has stated that B.Ed and M.Ed courses are in

- separate land & building. The details of the land, approved building plan, building completion certificate and earmarked built up area is not submitted.
5. Non-encumbrance certificate from the competent authority in English version is not submitted.
 6. Original FDRs for Rs. 5lacs and 3lacs towards Endowment and Reserve fund respectively from a Nationalized Bank in joint account for D.Ed, D.Ed-AI, B.Ed & M.Ed course is not submitted. The institution has submitted only two FDR's of 5 lakhs and 3 lakhs each from Tamilnadu Mercantile Bank Ltd., which is not a Nationalized Bank and not as per NCTE norms.
 7. No documentary proof is submitted for starting of language learning laboratory.

The reply of the institution is not convincing and not satisfactory.

Based on the above grounds, the committee decided not to permit shifting and further decided to withdraw the recognition of the four courses viz: D.T.Ed (APS00887), D.T.Ed-AI (APS05081),run by Luise James Teacher training Institute, Manavilai, Kappiyarai Post, Kanyakumari District – 629156, Tamilnadu & B.Ed (APS03622) & M.Ed (APS07543) course run by James Memorial Charitable Trust, Mananvilai, Near Karungal, Kappiyarai Post Kanyakumari-629156, Tamilnadu, from the academic year 2012-13, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in all the courses, if any to complete their course.

Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 27.02.2012.

The Hon'ble High Court of Madras vide interim order dt. 04.05.2012 in W.P. no. 12872 of 2012 and M.P. no. 2 of 2012 filed by Luise James Teacher Training Institute and James College of Education reads as follows:-

"..... these petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the argument of Mr.S.Doraisamy, for M/s.C.Robert Bruce, Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions the court made the following order:-

Notice of motion returnable in six weeks. Private notice is also permitted.

Interim stay of the operation of the impugned Act till then".

Accordingly, a letter sent to the Advocate Sri K.Ramakrishna Reddy on 05.06.2012 to defend the case. A counter affidavit was sent to the advocate on 23.07.2012.

A letter was received from Sri K.Ramakrishna Reddy on 16.10.2012 requesting for original inspection report for producing the same before the Hon'ble Court. Accordingly, original VT report sent to the Advocate on 17.10.2012.

Interim order dtd. 31.10.2012 reads as under:-

"..... learned counsel for the third respondent (SRC-NCTE, Bangalore) submitted that there are some mistakes while passing orders by the third respondent (SRC-NCTE Bangalore) and he will get the list of deficiencies to be complied with by the management and he has sought for time till Monday, i.e on 05.11.2012, to get particulars.

..... post on 05.11.2012. Interim order already granted by this Court is extended till then".

Further, an email was received from Advocate on 16.11.2012 regarding factual position as per records for grounds of withdrawal. Accordingly, a letter was sent to

the Advocate on 20.11.2012 with the following facts.

The Hon'ble court of Madras vide interim order dt. 21.11.2012 in W.P.No. 12872 of 2012 reads as follows:-				

“..... these petitions coming on for orders upon perusing the petitions and the respective affidavits filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. S. Doraisamy, for M/S. C. Robert Bruce, Advocate for the petitioner in both the petitions and of Mr. G. Anantharangan, Advocate for the 2nd respondents (The Registrar, Tamilnadu Teachers Education University, Lady Wellington College Campus, Kamarajar Salai, Chennai-5) in both the petitions the court made the following orders:-

At request of learned counsel for NCTE, Post the matter after one week.

Interim order already granted is extended”.

Further, the Hon'ble court of Madras vide interim order dt. 27.11.2012 in W.P.No. 12872 of 2012 reads as follows:-

The Hon'ble court of Madras vide interim order dt. 04.12.2012 in W.P.No. 12872 of 2012 reads as follows:-

The Hon'ble High court of Madras vide order dt. 09.01.2013 in W.P.No. 12872 of 2012 passed direction against Chief Educational Officer, Kanyakumari and also extended interim stay, as under:

“the Chief Educational officer amounts to committing contempt of court. However, this Court is willing to take a lenient view and a direction is issued to the first respondent (DTERT, Chennai) to take suitable action against the Chief Educational Officer, Kanyakumari District for issuing such a letter contrary to the interim order of this court. The first respondent (DTERT, Chennai) is directed to report about the action taken against the Chief Educational Officer, when the matter is taken up after six weeks. The Hon'ble High court of Madras vide interim order dt. 09.01.2013 in W.P.No. 12872 of 2012 passed the following order:

“..... The impugned order was passed based on the inspection report. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has strenuously submitted that if the inspection report is produced that could establish that the impugned order is contrary to the same. The same submission was also made on the earlier occasion. Hence this court on 10.10.2012 directed the learned counsel for the respondents to produce the inspection report based on which the final order passed and the matter was posted on 18.10.2012. When the matter was called on 19.10.2012, the inspection report was not produced. Thereafter, the matter was posted on 05.11.2012. Again the same was posted on 09.11.2012, 2012, 21.11.2012 and 27.11.2012. In the said circumstances, the writ petition was admitted on 04.12.2012 recording that in spite of granting time to produce the inspection report, the same is yet to be produced. Thereafter, the matter was listed on 20.12.2012 and today. But the inspection report is yet to be produced. The action of the respondent authority is highly contemptible in not producing the inspection report. Hence, a direction is issued to the respondents to produce the

inspection report based on which the final order was passed, failing which serious view will be taken by this Court. Learned counsel for the third respondent (SRC-NCTE, Bangalore) seeks time to produce the inspection report which is highly deprecated. Post the matter after six weeks for production of the inspection report by the respondents”.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 248th Meeting held on 13th-15th July, 2013 and SRC decided to file an affidavit as indicated and submit VT inspection Report copy along with it.

Accordingly, affidavit along with original inspection report was sent to Shri Ramakrishna Reddy on 19.07.2013. In reply, the advocate sent letter to SRC on 25.07.2013 and stated that “each High Court got its own procedure. It is a settled law that procedure of the Court is the law of the Court. As per the said procedure, a detailed counter affidavit along with vacate stay petition. M.P.No.3 of 2012 was filed”.

The SRC in its 250th Meeting held on 11th-13th August, 2013 considered the matter and advised Southern Regional Office to send reply to Advocate’s letter asking him to get remarks of the Court expunged. Accordingly, a letter was sent to the Advocate on 20.08.2013.

In reply, Shri K. Ramakrishna Reddy, Advocate sent a letter on 29.08.2013.

The SRC in its 254th meeting held on 25-27 October 2013 considered the matter and decided to take action according to decisions taken in the last meeting, i.e, in 253rd meeting held on 30th Sept & 01st Oct, 2013.

“In the 253rd meeting the members raised the issue relating to institution Luise James Teacher Training Institute and Luise James College of Education, Manavilai, Kapiyarai Post, Kanyakumari District – 629156, Tamilnadu. The issue related to mishandling of the case by SRO’s Lawyer Shri Ramakrishna Reddy. The Committee after discussing the matter decided as under:

1. In case No. (APS00887-D.T.Ed, APS05081-D.T.Ed-AI, APS03622-B.Ed & APS07543-M.Ed) relating to institution Luise James Teacher Training Institute and Luise James College of Education, Manavilai, Kapiyarai Post, Kanyakumari District-629156, Tamilnadu, application for grant of recognition to their D.T.Ed course on 30-12-2002, for D.T.Ed-AI on 30-12-2005, for B.Ed course on 30-12-2004 & for M.Ed course on 10-10-2006, the SRC and SRO have had to face avoidable embarrassment and hardships because of poor handling of the case by SRO’s Lawyer (Shri. Ramakrishna Reddy).
2. Inspite of repeated directions from the Court he did not file a copy of the VT Inspection report despite his having the report as sent by SRC. Also, inspite of repeated instructions from SRC/SRO, he failed to file an appeal. Instead of carrying out instructions in the best interests of the client, he has been dilly-dallying with meaningless prevarications.
3. After careful consideration of the details pertaining to this matter, SRC gave the following directions:
 - (i). The services of Shri. Ramakrishna Reddy as the Lawyer of SRC/SRO should be terminated with immediate effect.
 - (ii). A suitable Lawyer to replace him, should be indentified and appointed.

After perusal of memorandum of appeal, affidavit, the documents available on records and considering the oral arguments advanced during the hearing, the Council concluded that the appeal deserves to be remanded to SRC with a direction to issue a Show Cause Notice under clause 14(3)(b) of the NCTE Act.

The Council hereby remands back the case of CSI Teacher Training Institute for Women, Salem, Tamilnadu to the SRC,NCTE for necessary action as indicated above.

The SRC in its 268th meeting held on 4th -5th June 2014, decided and advised Southern Regional Office to process the said application after notification of new Regulations as per NCTE (H.Q) instructions.

An email dated 18.12.2014 was received from NCTE Hqrs regarding guidelines for processing of pending applications.

Accordingly, a willingness letter was issued to the institution on 19.12.2014. The institution submitted reply on 05.01.2015.

In view of the above circumstances, we request you to kindly intimate /advise Mahathma Gandhi University, Nalgonda district that the NCTE has already granted permission to Kavitha Memorial College of Education, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District for the academic year 2015-16 in leased accommodation with a condition that college has to shift to the permanent buildings in 2015-16 academic year itself, hence, the Mahathma Gandhi University may issue provisional affiliation to the college only for the academic year 2015-16 by taking and affidavit from the college.

We request you to advise the Mahathma Gandhi University to issue provisional affiliation to Kavitha Memorial College of Education, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District for the academic year 2015-16 as the NCTE has already granted permission to the college for the academic year 2015-16 in lease accommodation.

The SRC in its 292nd meeting held on 29th – 30th September, 2015 considered the matter and decided as under:

1. The legal position is that so long as NCTE recognition exists, Universities shall give affiliation to the institutions. It is our responsibility to get conditions like 'shifting' implemented. We are taking appropriate action to enforce the conditionalities until action in such cases is completed, Universities may be requested to continue to affiliate the institutions.
2. In all conditional recognition cases, we should issue Show Cause Notice for de-recognition for non-observance of conditionalities. The concerned affiliating Universities may be informed that we are taking action to enforce the conditionalities.

Meantime, the institution submitted representation on 24.09.2015 regarding change of the society (Management) along with original DD of Rs. 1,50,000/- bearing No.964296 dated 06.08.2015 and documents, it stated as follows:

"With reference to the subject and reference cited, this is to bring to your kind notice that the two letters dispatched to you vide reference 1st and 2nd cited have returned to the college by the courier due to wrong address written on the envelope by our office administrative assistant. I express my regrets for mistake caused in this regard and apologies for the same.

Once again I am forwarding the above two letters to you along with the same DD of Rs.1,50,000 towards change of the management from Kavitha Memorial Educational Society, Khammam to Uday Sai Educational Society, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District and also shifting of premises from temporary accommodation to the permanent buildings in Devarakonda, Nalgonda itself vide block No.20, H.No.288/914.

Submission of online application in NCTE web portal for change of management

under column e-governance is not getting up opened and the same issue was brought to the notice of NCTE Bangalore & New delhi (Mr.Pawan Bairagi) and we were advised to bring it to the notice of Member Secretary, New Delhi to modify the website. Hence, we hereby submitting the application in hard copy along with land documents, building Plan, staff approval list for 2014-15 and we request the NCTE, Bangalore for approval of change of management and shifting of premises”.

A letter was sent to the institution conveying decision of 292nd meeting, on 06.10.2015.

The documents were processed and agenda was placed before SRC in its 315th meeting held on 17th to 18th June, 2016 and the committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. *They have to shift premises.*
2. *But, before that they have changed the management. All the documents submitted now are in the name of the new management.*
3. *The ‘management’ issue has, therefore, to be settled before the ‘shifting’ matter can be considered.*
4. *Ask them to fulfill the formalities prescribed for change of management and apply separately for order thereon.*
5. *Only, thereafter, can this shifting matter be taken up for further action.*

Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC, a letter was issued to the institution on 12.07.2016 asking them to fulfill the formalities for change of management by submitting an application along with document as under:

- a) Resolution of the society
- b) NOC from the Registrar of Societies or Trust
- c) NOC from the affiliating bodies.

An e-mail was received from Advocate Ramakanth Reddy on 18.07.2016 along with W.P.No.23473 of 2016 filed by Kavitha Memorial Educational Society. Accordingly, letter was sent along with the brief of the institution on 18.07.2016.

On 21.07.2016, an e-mail was received from the Advocate, Shri. Ramakanth Reddy along with a copy of the Counter to be filed in W.P.No.23473/2016. A duly signed counter affidavit was sent to the advocate on 26.07.2016.

An e-mail received from the advocate on 27.07.2016 and 28.07.2016 along with the court order in W.P.No.23473 of 2016 and stated as follows:

“Kavitha College case was heard by the Hon’ble High Court today. The Hon’ble Court directed the SRC to conduct inspection on 30.07.2016 and submit report by Tuesday 02.08.2016 before the Court at 10.30 AM.

In view of the peculiar circumstances inspection was considered by me and the cut-off date fixed by Hon’ble Court and NOC will also be mentioned”.

The matter was placed before SRC in its 317th meeting held on 28th and 29th July, 2016 and the committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. The Court Order is noted.
2. In the circumstances of the case, for us, this is an un-implementable order.

3. Unless the formalities relating to change of management are completed, there can be no VT inspection because all documents are in favour of the new society.

4.1. The 'peculiar circumstances' cited by the Counsel are of his own creation.

4.2. If he cannot approach the court again on this matter, he should held us to get it done by another Lawyer.

An e-mail was received from the institution on 01.08.2016 and stated as follows:

"The Kavitha Memorial College of Education, Devarakonda, Nalgonda Dt, Telangana was supposed to be inspected by NCTE on 30.07.2016 at the new premises (block no 20, H-no-288/9/4, dindi road) of Uday Sai Educational Society to whom the society is being transferred. As per the Hon'ble High Court of AP & TS. WP no 23473 of 2016, The SRC NCTE is directed to depute a team for inspection of the premises from where 2nd petitioner (Kavitha Memorial College of Education) is proposed to be run and complete the inspection on 30.08.2016 and file in the court by 02.07.2016.

In view of the direction of the Hon'ble High court, the Management of the Kavitha Memorial College of Education and Uday Sai Educational society has arranged all infrastructural facilities like the premises, all relevant labs, faculty including principal for inspection at the new premises i.e (block no 20, H-no-288/9/4, dindi road) and waited till 7.00 PM on 30.07.2016 but no official of NCTE has come for inspection and no one has contacted us. We tried to contact the SRC NCTE office over telephone but no one has responded and we left at 7.00 PM. We request you to kindly look into the issue and solve it at the earliest to enable the college to get affiliation from MG university for this academic year as the college has already lost last year affiliation".

Meanwhile, an e-mail was received from the advocate Sri. Ramakanth Reddy, on 10.08.2016 alongwith draft Vacate Stay Petition and counter affidavit.

An e-mail was received from the NCTE-Hqrs on 15.08.2016 regarding approval of Counter Affidavit.

Accordingly, counter affidavit was sent to the advocate Sri. K. Ramakanth Reddy on 16.08.2016.

A court notice was received from the Hon'ble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in W.P.No. 23473 of 2016 dated 04.08.2016, on 12.08.2016, stating as under:

"Registry shall issue notice to 1st respondent to show cause why proceedings of contempt court shall not be initiated against 1st respondent for prima facie willful violation of the undertaking given before this court on 27.07.2016.

The 1st Respondent is also directed not to insist on the petitioners producing NOC from the Affiliating Body and the State Government as per the letter dt. 12.07.2016 for the purpose of considering the issue of transfer of management of the 2nd petitioner-college.

1st respondent is also directed to consider petitioners' application dt. 16-09-2015 within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order since already much time has elapsed since its submission and since prima facie the 1st Respondent in its proceeding dt. 12.07.2016 does not appear to have applied its mind to the contents of the application dt. 16.09.2015 made by the petitioners.

Post on 18.08.2016 for admission of contempt case.”

now, another letter received from the institution on 16.08.2016 stating as under:

“ we, the Kavitha Memorial College of Education, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District, humbly submit a few issues for your kind consideration. Kavitha Memorial Educational Society and Uday Sai Educational Society are mutually agreed and passed resolutions to transfer the management of Kavitha Memorial College of Education, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District to Uday Sai College of Education under Uday Sai Educational Society, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District.

The Kavitha Memorial Educational Society has paid the prescribed fee of Rs. 1.50.000/- (Rupees one lakh fifty thousand only) to the SRC, NCTE towards change of management and shifting of the premises to block No. 20, H.No. 288/9/4, Dindi Road, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District vide application dt. 16.09.2016.

Now we request you to kindly depute your officials to inspect the premises at block No. 20, H.No.288/9/4, Dindi Road, Devarakonda, Nalgonda District of Uday Sai College of Education under Uday sai Educational Society to whom the management of Kavitha Memorial College of Education is being transferred after your inspection. Please inspect the premises at the earliest to enable the college to get affiliation for this academic year from Mahatma Gandhi University, Nalgonda as the college has already lost last year affiliation.

The advocate sent a letter seeking extension of time for placing the order before SRC. Accordingly, a signed application was sent to the advocate on 18.08.2016 informing that the matter will be placed in the 319th meeting to be held on 30th-31st August & 01st September, 2016 for decision.

The SRC in its 319th meeting held on 30th-31st August, 2016 considered the court order and institution's written representation dated 16.08.2016 and decided as under:

1. Let us cause inspection as directed by the High Court without conceding the applicant's request for change of management
2. The applicant will have to fulfill all the legal requirements for allowing change of management, transfer of title to properties as well as adhere to norms and standards
3. Issue orders for VT inspection
4. Inform the lawyer accordingly

Accordingly, an e-mail was sent to the Advocate conveying the decision of SRC 319th meeting on 09.09.2016.

As per the decision of SRC, VT assigned through online procedure. The Inspection of the institution was conducted on 13.09.2016 and VT report along with CD and Pen drive received on 16.09.2016.

The documents were processed and placed before SRC in its 320th meeting held on 19th – 20th September 2016. The Committee considered the matter and decided as under:

1. Change of Management and shifting case B.Ed (1 unit)

2. Land document is in order
3. EC is in order
4. LUC is in order
5. BP is in order
6. BCC is in order. Built up area is adequate for one unit.
7. FDRs date expired and in the name of Kavitha Memorial College of Education,
8. Faculty list not given
9. Issue SCN for latest faculty list.
10. Regarding change in management they should give required documents
11. The institution has requested for only one unit of B.Ed. Withdraw recognition for the 2nd unit w.e.f 2016-17.

A Vacate Stay Petition in W.P.No. 23473 of 2016 was received from Advocate Sri. Ramakanth Reddy on 23.09.2016.

Duly signed Vacate Stay Petition in respect of W.P.No. 23473 of 2016 filed by Kavitha Memorial Educational Society was sent to the Advocate Sri. Ramakanth Reddy on 23.09.2016.

Before issuance of show cause notice, as per the website information the institution submitted its reply along with Faculty List on 26.09.2016, it stated as under:
