

1. In terms of the communication vide e-mail dt 13 Feb, 2015 of the NCTE (HQ), Regional Committees are required to issue Revised Requisition Orders to the existing Institutions who have to shift to 2-year B.Ed / M.Ed / B.P.Ed courses.
2. Preliminary scrutiny has shown that many cases suffer from different types of deficiencies. It may not be possible for the SRO, within its staff-limitations, to complete detailed examination of the records of the large number of existing recognized institutions urgently so as to be able to take a final stand in their cases before the universities / SCERTs close their affiliation process by mid-May.
3. Covering only some cases and not others within the time available may give rise to complaints of discrimination.
4. These institutions, after all, have been functioning all this while in their present form. There can therefore be no objection to their continuing to function provided they are required to remove all deficiencies, in accordance with the 2014 Regulations, before 30 October, 2015.
- 5.1. Accordingly, Regional Director (SRO) is authorized to issue Revised Recognition Orders in all the 'cases of shifting' (listed in Annexure-II of the note submitted) and in all the 'cases of other deficiencies' (listed in Annexure-V of the note submitted).
- 5.2. In the Revised Recognition Order, it should very clearly be stated that the deficiencies listed, therein should be remedied before 31 July 2015 failing which their recognition would be withdrawn.
- 5.3. Regional Director (SRO) shall maintain a check – list of all such cases so that inspection can be conducted during August – September-October 2015.
6. The 2014 Regulations make no mention of a Minority Certificate. That being so, there is no need to single out for special attention, the cases of the Institutions listed in Annexure – III of the note submitted.
- 7.1. There are many institutions (listed in Annexure-IV) of the note submitted that have not revalidated their FDRs. This is not a major deficiency for holding up the Revised Recognition Order. It can be issued on the condition that the institution shall submit

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revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC, before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition would be withdrawn.

- 7.2. Regional Director (SRO) shall maintain a check-list of all such cases so that action to withdraw recognition can be taken in case of failure to comply with the requirement.
8. All the other institutions that have been seen to have no deficiencies can straightaway be issued Revised Recognition Orders for the 2 year B.P.Ed/B.Ed course.
9. No RPROs need be issued in cases of institutions that have not filed the required affidavit expressing willingness to be governed by the 2014 Regulations.
10. Lists of institutions falling in the different categories may be sent to all the Universities in the Region.

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
