**PUBLIC NOTICE**

National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), established under the NCTE Act, 1993 with a view to achieve planned and coordinated development of teacher education system and in order to regulate the growth of teacher education at all levels, has brought out new Regulations i.e. NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009 on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009. All the institutions/societies willing to start teacher education courses or seeking enhancement of seats in the existing teacher education courses are requested to go through the new Regulations and Norms and Standards, which are available on the NCTE Website [www.ncte-india.org](http://www.ncte-india.org).

As per para 8 (13) of the above Regulation, all the existing teacher education institutions have to comply with the requirement laid down in the revised Norms and Standards and also increase the built up area within one year as stipulated in Appendixes 1 to 13 of the above Regulations from the date of effect of revised norms i.e. on or before 31<sup>st</sup> August 2010.

Further, all the institutions granted recognition for additional intake in B.Ed and B.P.Ed courses after promulgations of NCTE Regulations 2005 i.e. on 13<sup>th</sup> January 2009 shall have to get itself accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a Letter Grade B under the new grading system developed by NAAC, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> Day of April 2010 failing which additional intake granted shall stand withdrawn w.e.f. academic session 2010-2011.
